## CIRCUMFERENCE TEST

Use a flexible measuring tape (or a string \& ruler) to measure your finger circumference.

Wrap it snugly around your finger for an accurate measurement.
If using a string or ribbon, cut right where the 2 ends meet.
Be careful not to wrap the string too tight.
Aim for a comfortable, snug fit.
Double check for accuracy.
With a ruler, measure the length of the string in cm or inch.
The result is your finger circumference.
Look up your size by referring to the chart on the left.
