Officer Smith #12696, Unit #17633, LAPD Dovenshire District, was contacted and stated that above victim had called from Topanga Blvd., and Dovenshire stating that she had just been beaten up by her husband while at the above location.

We then questioned the victim, who stated that at approximately 11:00PM she arrived at the Spahn Ranch and entered the main building where there were approximately 25 persons sitting about. She then confronted her husband, suspect #1, and requested that he return their 10 month old son to her or she would take him to court. She stated that he then refused and stated that if she took him to court, he and the "Straight Satans" would kill her. He then punched her on the face with his closed fist, which caused her to fall to the floor, and began kicking her about the body and head. At this time suspect #2 began to kick her about the body and then he dragged her from the room by her hair. Both suspects were wearing Engineer type boots. The victim was driven to Dovenshire and Tepanga Cyn., by a girl friend "Laure" HFD, where she contacted LAFD regarding above.

We observed that there was a small amount of dried blood on her right cheek area of the victim's face. There was also a small cut just right of the victim's mouth and she was bleeding slightly from the nose. At this time victim refused medical aid, stating that she would seek her own doctor. We then returned to the Spahn Ranch where upon the victim stated that the Harley M/C lic.#5084 (Arizona) (MW#3841415), that was parked in front of the location, belonged to suspect #1. She further stated that suspect #1 an #2 were staying at the location for the last three days. We searched the area with negative results. The above M/C was checked via Auto Statis and returned no wants. The victim is desirous of prosecution and can be contacted daily at her residence.
