

CCMR Goal

Our goal is that 100% of AAHS scholars graduate having earned a CCMR credit. To help support scholars with this, we have a variety of different opportunities and avenues that scholars can take to earn the credit.

AP Courses

We offer a variety of AP courses that scholars are encouraged to take including AP courses that have been historically quite successful for our students.

ACC HB5 College Preparatory Courses

Through a partnership with ACC, AAHS offers advanced college preparatory courses in both English and Math classes for seniors. Scholars who successfully complete the course and end-of-course examination are marked as TSI complete, pending completion of 1 successful semester at ACC.

TSIA 2.0

Scholars begin testing for the TSIA 2.0 in the 9th grade and are offered numerous different opportunities to test throughout their four years of high school, totaling at least 4 opportunities.

TSI Prep Course

Scholars in 12th grade complete a TSI prep course offered through CollegeSpring and featuring small group pullout sessions with their College Seminar 12 instructor.

ACT

Scholars are offered three opportunities to take the ACT test, two in the Spring of their Junior year, and one in the fall of their Senior year.

ACT Prep Course

In our College Seminar courses, mandatory for all grades 9-12, scholars receive targeted ACT prep to improve their testing knowledge, skills and strategies. ACT prep is concentrated in College Seminar 11 courses before scholars test, with over a month of targeted ACT instruction in total.

Onramps UT Dual Enrollment

Through the Onramps program at UT, scholars can earn dual credit at the University of Texas. We offer two Onramps courses in Geoscience and College Algebra.

Distinguished Graduation Plans for Scholars with IEP's

All scholars at Austin Achieve are slated to graduate with the Distinguished graduation plan. Scholars with IEP's have the support needed to graduate on this rigorous plan.
