Next we have the **Boston Terrier**, its exercise needs are not as high as the Beagles however it is just as difficult to house train.

Again this breed is good with kids and pets with the main point to mention with this breed is that they make excellent watchdogs.

After the Boston we have the **Shiba Inu**, this breed of dog shed an incredible amount of fur and are not suited to dog allergy sufferers.

On the plus side they are good with children and pets and are relatively easy to house train if you have the patience and experience for this type of breed.

Next we have the **Welsh Terrier**, this is not a dog you want to have around small pets like cats, it will chase them and may injure them.

This breed have medium exercise requirements and are good around children and re classed as a low shedding small dog breed.

Last we have the **Lhasa Apso**, these little dogs are pretty good with children and will shed some fur but not a lot.

This is another small dog breed that could well be problematic when it comes to house training. However, this breed will definitely make you a good little watchdog that's for sure.
