THE ROOT OF BLEACH





Our government don't really have a solution to our challenge but they are doing their best to save us


Let us all take precautions, let us unite, let us listen to what we are being told and we will beat the virus





Then your crooked smile became my cup of tea


I got lost between the freckles underneath your eyes

Like the constellation, i was mesmerized


The stars aligned
