TO: The Loyola Schools Community

Be mindful of criminal elements which are particularly active during the Christmas season along Katipunan and in and around Barangay Loyola Heights.

Separate incidents of hold-up / robberies have taken place along Katipunan in front of the hi-rise construction (between Oracle Hotel and Sweet Inspiration) even on weekend nights.

These criminals use getaway vehicles (ie. red Innova van and motorcycles).

What to do:

- Prevent being out along Katipunan from 12:00 midnight until 4:00 AM unless completely necessary
- Be vigilant. Scan your environment. Check for suspicious-looking characters even in public areas
- Be wary of slow vehicles trailing you as you walk or vehicles that suddenly stop or cut you off along Katipunan.
- Keep your valuables hidden on your person. Do not hand-carry cellphones, tablets, wallets. Avoid bringing large amounts of cash.
- In the event of an impending encounter, duck into the nearest open establishment. Report suspicious-looking characters to the barangay tanods, security guards, and/or Ateneo Security
- In the event of a holdup, cooperate. The robbers are armed and experienced, and likely have accomplices hidden nearby. Give them your valuables, and shout for help only when your life is threatened or after you have been robbed. Do not pursue.
- Immediately report any untoward incident of theft, robbery and harassment to the Office for Student Services, G/F Xavier Hall
