

**Washington State Patrol
LASER (SMD) Radar Affidavit**

This affidavit incorporates by reference Notice of Infraction / Citation # . On this date, time, and location listed on the Notice of Infraction, the defendant was observed at a speed, which appeared to be in excess of the posted speed limit of 70 MPH. RCW 46 61.400.

I was operating the Pro Laser III Speed Monitoring Device, serial number L 1398. This Laser SMD is used only in the stationary position. This Laser SMD is a device approved for use in Washington State and has been certified to be in proper working order by both factory and Washington State Patrol technicians. I have received training in the use and operation of this Laser SMD and am qualified to operate it.

The Laser SMD showed the visible display of 81 miles per hour which was consistent with my visual speed estimation of the defendant's vehicle at a range of 1179 feet. The vehicle I obtained the speed and distance reading on was approaching my location. I located the defendant's vehicle in the view finder on this Laser SMD. I placed the red box on the defendant's vehicle. I pulled the trigger on the Laser SMD to obtain this speed and distance reading.

The vehicle was stopped was the same vehicle that I checked with this Laser SMD traveling over the posted speed limit. .

This Laser SMD was checked before, and after the stop, and was found to be in proper working order. The operation check was performed by the use of three tests: (1) Internal Self-Diagnostic Test; (2) Scope Alignment Test; and (3) The speed differential test at 150 and 175 feet.

The defendant was given a copy of the Notice of Infraction, told to read the instructions, and to respond to the court within 15 days.

The weather and road conditions were: Dry Wet Clear Sunny Overcast Rain
Partly Cloudy Fog Snow Ice
