I. The Prophetic

When one hears the word prophetic, it is mostly prophecy that comes to mind. Everyone, somehow might have at least once encountered, or heard of a prophet or someone who prophesies.

There are a lot of things to be said about the prophetic, but as this is a training material, we shall limit our information on what matters, in relation to the goal this training material needs to reach.

Let me tell you what the prophetic is not:

- The prophetic is not prophecy, but prophecy is part of the prophetic
- The prophetic is not visions, but visions are ones of the many functions of the prophetic
- Etc.

Joe 2:28 And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions:
 2:29 And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my

2:29 And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my spirit.

What these verses are telling us is that, in the last days, when the Holy Spirit comes on every one, God would restore the prophetic office in the Church, and not limit it to a group of people, but on everyone to operate within it. Hallelujah. Everything mentioned; prophecy, visions, dreams, etc... are integral parts of the prophetic.

The prophetic is a realm of Revelation and Communication. It is access into supernatural omniscience knowledge of God, in order to reveal the mind of God, regarding a people, nation, according to a situation in time past, present and future.

The prophetic was limited only to a group of people, the prophets, in the Old Testament/Covenant; few chosen people that God would anoint for a moment/season for a special assignment to announce the Word and reveal the thoughts of God for His people or the heathen. But these verses tell that, since the Holy Ghost came, everyone can hear and listen to God, and God can reveal anything to anyone. Glory to God. Through the New Covenant, I don't have to be a prophet to be prophetic, even though being prophetic is a requisite to being a prophet. But even if I am not called into the office of a prophet, I can still be prophetic.

Gen 1:1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

The Bible tells that God started by creating the heavens, before He could create the earth. The heavens here is not a destination, but a spiritual atmosphere or realm upon the earth (physical realm), that rules and regulates the latter. This means, if we are to do or say anything here on earth – physical, we must first regulate it or receive it from heaven – the spiritual.

To every earth is attached a heaven, and your level in the prophetic (knowledge and maturity in the spiritual realms) determines how you operate on your earth.

The Apostolic is the ability to control a land (the earth from the heaven), and the Prophetic is the ability to interact with the land (the earth from the heaven).

Identifying the move of God is being prophetic, and moving with the move of God is being Apostolic.

Being a prophetic person means, being able to operate in the prophetic realm, or the spiritual realm of revelation even without being a prophet. It is being able to hear God, and speak for God. It is being able to locate the move of God and catch the flow of His spirit.

The Bible talks about a generation of prophetic people, though they were not prophets, but they were very prophetic and were consulted by others to know the will of God.

1Ch 12:32 And of the children of Issachar, which were men that had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do; the heads of them were two hundred; and all their brethren were at their commandment.

Now, the world needs Christians to stand like the sons of Issachar and be able to tell it, JESUS is coming back soon, repent from your evil ways. *Numbers* 11:24-29

But let me mention something crucial here, **the most important purpose of the prophetic is to reveal JESUS CHRIST,** that's why all prophecies in the Old Testament were pointing directly to the person of Jesus or to the works of the person of Jesus. Every operation in the prophetic that doesn't point, nor reveal Jesus Christ, is not from God.

But, please note that a prophetic believer is limited, because there are some dimensions reserved for them that are called in the office as officers, the prophets.

In this manual, I will dwell mostly on the Prophetic in general as an office and not the officer – the Prophet.

II. The Holy Ghost and the Prophetic

The Holy Spirit. What an amazing person we have, what a friend we have, what a counselor we have in Him. Everything we do as believers are orchestrated and managed by Him. He is the source of all gifts and all operations. He is the governor of the spiritual realms. We cannot do anything without Him, and we cannot operate, grow and function in the prophetic without Him.

A good and intimate relationship with the Holy Spirit is a requisite for operating in the prophetic and knowing the voice of God. This material is not focused on the Holy Ghost, but it is important to understand few things about the Holy Ghost and the Prophetic.

- The Holy Spirit is the master of the Prophetic, there is no prophetic manifestation without Him
- The Holy Spirit is the giver of the Prophetic gifts, therefore He controls their use
- The Holy Spirit is the prime minister of the government of Christ on earth the Church, therefore, no officer/minister can work without a constant relationship/communication with Him

As I previously mentioned, the prophetic is the office, but the tools are needed in order to operate in it. Those tools are discussed in the book, but we need to understand that the Holy Ghost is the source of the prophetic; therefore He is the link between us and God through the prophetic.

In order to operate in the prophetic, one needs the prophetic gifts of the Spirit. But in order to receive those gifts, one needs to be baptized in the Spirit/Fire. And in order to be baptized in Fire, one needs to have received the Holy Spirit within them, that is, receiving Jesus Christ as your personal Lord and savior. Because the Holy Spirit only comes UPON us as FIRE, when He already inhabits us.

a. Identifying the Voice of God

One of the most difficult things for men is to hear God, yet God speaks to us, all the time. The Bible says

Job 33:14 For God may speak in one way, or in another, Yet man does not perceive it.

In the above scripture, there is a mention of something very interesting, it says, God speaks all the time but we do not perceive. In other words, the fact that we don't hear God doesn't mean God doesn't speak.

When babies are born, you can sing to them songs, they will not understand what you are saying, it sounds gibberish, just like when a baby speaks it sounds gibberish to us, but it doesn't mean that we are not saying anything. Many people claim that God doesn't speak to them, simply because they are unable to identify the voice of God.

Let me mention some reasons why many people can't hear God, nor identify when it is God.

- Narrow-Mind. When you box God, you miss God. You can't expect God to speak to you ONLY as you think He should. God is sovereign, you should have a flexible spirit
- Lack of intimacy. Intimacy with God, closeness with God gives you the ability to master the voice of God. The more time a baby spends with their mother, they master the voice of their mother. *John 10:1-29*
- **Misinterpretation of the Voice**. Many people think when God speaks to us, it is that big audible voice calling out your name like in movies. God's voice can sound just a sweet small though/voice/thought in your heart/head.

Now it is important to mention that we cannot master all of God's ways of communication, but to each individual, there is a way in which God commonly speaks to you. Before I go into some ways in which you can know it is God speaking to you, let me mention something very important.

The Voice and The Message.

It is important to note that, a voice is different from a message. But every voice carries a message. A voice can be a noise to you if the message is not understood. The voice is the means, and the message is the end. Therefore, hearing God is not a problem, but understanding the message is.

There are various ways through which God spoke and still speaks. But I will categorize them into 3 groups

- Before the fall
- After the fall the Old Covenant and
- After redemption the New Covenant

Hebrews 1:1 God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets,

1:2 has in these last days spoken to us by His Son, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the worlds;

• Before the fall

In this part, I am referring to the time Adam and Eve were still in the Garden of Eden, before they disobeyed God and sinned. In Genesis we understand that, man and God were one, to the point where I personally believe they were communicating directly through the power of thoughts. The thoughts of God were the thoughts of man. God communicated directly to Adam, from within because before the fall, man was a spirit man, having an incorruptible body that wasn't limited, neither by time nor by space, nor matter. *Genesis 1-2*

• After the fall – the Old Covenant

The first time God spoke to man after the fall was right after they sinned, and the Bible says,

Gen 3:8 And they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day,

God came to speak and His voice was heard walking, I believe before the fall, the voice was heard living in them. Now since they had sinned and the Glory left them – but the Gory didn't leave the garden as the garden was God's presence and habitation, the voice was still heard from the garden but not from within no more.

After Adam was cast out of the garden, God developed another means of communication, even though we have no precision on how God was speaking to them, but we can rest assured that they were able to identify God, because of the seed of God in them from the time they had spent in the garden.

Then God had to introduce a new pattern of communication in order to start a new breed of people to prepare the coming new covenant, of blood – the blood of Jesus. So God had to start locating a few people in different times and seasons in order to use them specifically and even as spokespeople to others.

In the Old Covenant, God would directly speak to specific people, in different manners. Not everyone was able to hear God, because of sin, and the presence of God had left the man. But God would choose a few people every now and then, and He would enable to hear Him.

God spoke to Adam, Abel, Seth, Enoch, all the way to Abraham, as it is believed, audibly because they would hear God like Samuel (*1Samuel 3:4*) calling them out. To Moses God spoke through fire, (*Exodus 3:1-4, chap. 20*). To others, He spoke in dreams and visions up until Matthew, when God was speaking through dreams and visions even to Joseph – Jesus's godfather (*Matthew 2:19*). God spoke to many others through angelic visitations also, etc...

But it is worth noticing that, everyone who used to directly communicate with God, was either a prophet, or directly considered as such, that is why the Bible says in Hebrews, that in old times God spoke through prophets, but NOW, He speaks differently.

• After redemption – the New Covenant

The Bible says in this season or dispensation, God speaks to us through JESUS CHRIST. Hallelujah

That simply means, you cannot claim to have heard God unless it is THROUGH JESUS. Jesus Himself claimed to be the only way to GOD. The ONLY way to communicate with God. The ONLY way to reach God. The ONLY way to hear God.

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

But we all know that Jesus had left the world, but He sent us Jesus unlimited, the Holy Spirit. Therefore, we can only hear God through the Holy Spirit. Only the Holy Spirit can help us, hear, interpret, and translate the voice of God to us.

God still uses different means like:

- Dreams and Visions
- Audibly
- Angelic Visitations
- Thoughts
- Etc...

But no matter HOW God speaks to you, you must identify 3 elements.

- That it is backing or confirming the Word of God for you (Bible), not contradicting it
- Comes with conviction, a strong conviction
- Brings peace after you obey/release/follow it

One of the most difficult things is to identify the HOW God speaks to you regularly. God can use 100 means or manner to speak to you, but there is always a means or manner through which He will use to communicate to you, very much often.

For example: If God speaks to you through THOUGHTS, then you will know it is God because

- It confirms the Word of God for you, cannot contradict the WORD
- It comes with a strong conviction that is not from you
- Brings peace when you obey/release/follow it

If you identify one means through which God speaks to you with the above elements, then you have found the key for your growth in the prophetic.

III. 3 types of the Prophetic People

It is very important to note the 3 main types of prophetic people. When I say types, it has nothing to do with **HOW** God speaks to us, but **HOW** we react to His voice.

As with respect to the prophets, we have various types of them as to how they receive from God and how they speak on His behalf. Some prophets are intercessory prophets, they receive messages, but never speak them out, but they pray them through their fulfillment. Some are prophets with no accuracy in details, but very accurate in timing of fulfillment of their messages. *And many more types which we will discuss in the book, Volume 2.*

The way our body, soul and spirit respond to the voice of God differs from one person to another. That is why I found out that, we can categorize it into 3 main types. **Seers, Hearers and Feelers**.

a. Seers

The seers are them that see. **They hear God through their eyes of the spirit**. When God speaks, they see. They are more used to visions and dreams. Prophets seers are called Ro'eh, actually, in the Old Testament, prophets were known as seers. (*Isaiah 6:1*).

Joseph was a seer (*Genesis 37:5-13*). He used to see the future through dreams. And most of the seers, like Joseph, when they mature in the prophetic, they become interpreters of dreams. In other words, when one masters and grow and mature in his office, they start interpreting their office.

Seers have visions, or at times when God speaks to them, they have small flashes of images passing through their minds/spirit to make the voice clear.

b. Hearers

The hearers are typical hearers. When God speaks, they hear. It is possible to be a hearer and a seer at the same time, but hearers are more common to hearing the voice of God. They can hear the voice of God audibly in their ears of their spirits, and even when God speaks to them through thoughts, they hear the thoughts being read to them. You hear a voice inside your heart/head/mind.

Samuel was a hearer (1Samuel 3:4), and many other prophets as well.

Most people start as hearer and develop into seers. Because, hearing is the common means for all/many Christians. When God speaks, we hear.

c. Feelers

Feelers are them that generally get to feel the mood of God. God communicates His feelings to them. They tend to have their moods change and vary every now and then, especially when ministering.

Feelers feel the voice of God, when God speaks, they feel. Have you ever heard someone say, *I feel God wants me to do this, or I feel God is sad because of this or that?* They are feelers.

Jeremiah the prophet was a hearer, a seer but also a feeler. Most of the time God would speak to him about a doom coming on a city, he would feel the mood of God, either anger or compassion. Moses was also a feeler; he felt the anger of God when Israel worshipped the golden calf (*Exodus 20*)

IV. Image-Nation

As we grow into the prophetic, we need to understand the world of images. The prophetic needs your mind, but first needs you to be transformed.

Rom 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Inner transformation comes with the Renewing of the MIND. Your mind is very important to your growth in God and in life, and also for your mastery of the prophetic realms.

There is one thing I want to dwell upon, your imagination.

Has it ever happened to you that, while you are praying and speaking in tongues, a certain image pops up in your mind, which is so inappropriate that you even wonder how your mind could bring such an image up at that specific time? Well, it is because your mind has a nation within it called IMAGINATION, which is a NATION of IMAGES. It is there that, all the images are stored. It is important to be able to control that nation because everything regarding your confession is somehow influenced by it.

Imagination^a

i-maj-i-nā´shun (שרירוּת, yēcer, שרירוּת, sh^erīrūth; διάνοια, diánoia): "Imagination" is the translation of yēcer, properly "a shaping," hence, "a thought" (<u>Gen 6:5</u>; <u>Gen 8:21</u>; <u>Deu 31:21</u>; <u>1Ch 28:9</u>; <u>1Ch 29:18</u>). In <u>Isa_26:3</u> yēcer is translated "mind" (King James Version margin "thought" or "imagination"), "whose mind is stayed on thee" (the Revised Version margin "or imagination"); in <u>Psa_103:14</u> it is "frame".

It is important to note that, imagination also means shaping, which means, you shape your mind by the images you put in it. God told Abram

Gen 13:14 And the LORD said to Abram, after Lot had separated from him: "Lift your eyes now and look from the place where you are; northward, southward, eastward, and westward;
13:15 "for all the land which you see I give to you and your descendants forever.

In other words, God was telling Abram, use your imagination, as far as you can imagine this land that is what you get. God linked Abram's blessing to his ability to see *in his mind*.

There is a great difference between imagining and guessing. When you imagine, you are creating images about what you are thinking about, therefore, you are seeing it in your mind.

One needs to understand that in order to grow and operate in the prophetic, you need to master the nation of your images. You need to put in it, images of where you want to go, and see what you need to see.

Example: when prophesying for someone, and you hear God speak to you about something regarding them, one of the way to get accurate is when, while receiving the messages, you start envisioning the message in your mind, you will provoke God (especially if you are a seer) to break into your imagination and drop some images for you.

If your mind is full of wrong images, it is because you have exposed yourself to wrong things. That is why many servants of God, especially them that have the prophetic gifts, the devil fight us with lust, and binds many into pornography and sexual impurity, in order to pollute our minds. Your deliverance is not only through prayer, you need to invade your mind with the word of God, and expose yourself to the right images, until God's obsession becomes yours.

Image-nation is a matter of the Mind.

Phi 4:8 Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy; meditate on these things.

Paul tells us that it is possible to discipline our minds and train them to think and perceive what is right. When your mind is trained, you will learn to pay attention to details in the prophetic.

Dan 1:8 But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's delicacies, nor with the wine which he drank; therefore he requested of the chief of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.

A life of sin, of any kind, robbery, lies, immorality, destroys the prophetic presence of God in a vessel.

V. The importance and place of the Word of God

LISTEN: A prophetic person must be a Word-addict. It is extremely important to understand that the WORD of GOD is the main substantial element in the prophetic. Not even prayer.

Prayer in the Greek, proseuche^a means to take out what is within. What do you put within if it is

not the word of God; therefore, even prayer is with no substance without the Word of God. Faith empowers your prayer, and the Word of God gives substance to your prayer.

No man can expect growth in the prophetic without being an addict of the Word of God. The Word of God balances your imaginations, strengthens your prophetic gifts, empowers your life, and gives you focus.

Rev 10:8 Then the voice which I heard from heaven spoke to me again and said, "Go, take the little book which is open in the hand of the angel who stands on the sea and on the earth."
10:9 So I went to the angel and said to him, "Give me the little book." And he said to me, "Take and eat it; and it will make your stomach bitter, but it will be as sweet as honey in your mouth."
10:10 Then I took the little book out of the angel's hand and ate it, and it was as sweet as honey in my mouth. But when I had eaten it, my stomach became bitter.
10:11 And he said to me, "You must prophesy again about many peoples, nations, tongues, and kings."

As you can realize in this portion of the Bible that John was already prophesying, but because God was about to give him more prophetic messages on a broader audience, there was need for him to swallow the WORD. It was compulsory that he made the WORD part of him, because the Word brings something into you that has no substitute.

There is another thing the Word of God does into your life that I want to mention here,

Heb 4:12 For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

The Bible says the Word of God is:

- Living: It is life; it brings *life* to your life.
- **Powerful**: The Word of God, is power to your life, it brings balance into your prophetic domain.
- Sharper than any two-edged sword: It sharpens your spirit, and brings accuracy of operation into your gifts.

- Divides soul and spirit: this is one of the most important things that the Word of God does to you, it isolates your soul from your spirit, and thus enabling your mind to take time to process the information coming from your spirit in order to translate it as it ought to be done. When your mind processes information separately from your spirit, even details like names get more accurate, because names are stored in your mind, but the message comes from the spirit, therefore when the message comes, the mind has the time to process and identify the names that go along with it.
- **Discerner of thoughts and hearts**: this is what brings prophetic accuracy, and being able to locate and see into people's hearts and discern their intents.

Poor and inaccurate prophecy is a product of poverty in the word. Consume the Word daily and don't stop until the Word consumes you from within.

a. Renewing of the Mind

Eze 3:1 Moreover He said to me, "Son of man, eat what you find; eat this scroll, and go, speak to the house of Israel."

3:2 So I opened my mouth, and He caused me to eat that scroll.

3:3 And He said to me, "Son of man, feed your belly, and fill your stomach with this scroll that I give you." So I ate, and it was in my mouth like honey in sweetness.

3:4 Then He said to me: "Son of man, go to the house of Israel and speak with My words to them.

Nobody has to right to speak on behalf of God until they have swallowed the scroll of the WORD. The Word of God renews your Mind. Your mind needs constant renewal in order to keep upgraded with the advancement of the operation of the Holy Ghost in the prophetic.

Rom 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. *12:2* And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your

mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

The Bible says that we should offer ourselves up as LIVING sacrifices before you renew your mind. Here is why.

Because a renewed mind on a body not fully offered to God will create unbalance on your spirit.

Because you sacrifice is an expression of your love for God, and it helps kill your flesh on you in order for the spirit to fully manifest. Until you die to the flesh, who you are in the spirit can never

be made manifest. Therefore, when you die to the flesh, as a living sacrifice, you give access to the spirit, then when your mind get renewed and your spirit reigning over the flesh, the spirit has more freedom to communicate to your mind and your mind has more freedom to process the information and then translate it to you in a language you understand and suitable to you.

VI. Prayer Points

As you are about to finish this material, I want to give you some prayer points that will help you work on, and pray as you decide to go deeper into your journey in the prophetic.

These are only but a few prayer points that helped me, and still do, which I believe will also help you. Don't forget, *prayer is an activity of the spirit; therefore the Holy Spirit should always be your map in the journey of prayer.*

Here are some prayer points:

- Lord baptize me in the River of Fire and give me the spirit of prayer and fasting
- Lord give me the Grace to pray but also with a strong and mighty thirst and hunger for your Word
- Lord, enlighten the eyes of my understanding. Eph. 1:18
- Lord, make me quick to understand. Isa. 1:3
- Lord, make me able to translate all revelations and dreams and prophetic insights. Dan. 1:17
- Lord, increase my hunger for the Holy Spirit and make me more intimate with Him like never before. John 16
- Lord, connect me to the right frequency of heaven AT ALL TIME.
- Lord, connect me to the people assigned to help me grow in my life and ministry, and remove them that have hidden agendas in the name of Jesus.
- Every satanic plot against my life and ministry, to instigate people against me, weaken me and make me lose my way, may it catch FIRE in Jesus' name.
- I condemn every tongue that rises against me for no reason, in order to curse me or discredit my name amongst the nations.
- God, give me a clean heart, and an available spirit. Ps 51
- Lord, destroy laziness in my life, kill envy and damage my ego in Jesus' name.
- Lord, give me the ability to operate like Jesus in everything I do, having the same motives and same results in Jesus' name.
- Lord, allow my spirit to be quiet and sharp before you in order to hear from you as clearly as you speak to me.
- Lord, separate me from anything that I love more than you. Give me the strength to attend my own funeral daily, without crying over my own case. Make me to die daily, to self, in order to manifest who I am in the spirit. **1Co. 15:17**

Conclusion

Son of man, Prophesy

Understanding the prophetic is one thing, growing in the prophetic is another. Understanding comes after accumulation of knowledge, and growth comes with wisdom, which is application of knowledge. Understanding is passive, and growth is active. And the more you practice knowledge, the more you grow into it, and that's wisdom.

Eze 37:4 Again He said to me, "Prophesy to these bones, and say to them, 'O dry bones, hear the word of the LORD!

In the verse above, God told Ezekiel, to prophesy. But before that, let us read the previous verses.

Eze 37:1 The hand of the LORD came upon me and brought me out in the Spirit of the LORD, and set me down in the midst of the valley; and it *was* full of bones.

Eze 37:2 Then He caused me to pass by them all around, and behold, *there were* very many in the open valley; and indeed *they were* very dry.

Eze 37:3 And He said to me, "Son of man, can these bones live?" So I answered, "O Lord GOD, You know."

Verse 1, says: the hand of the Lord was upon him. It means, nobody can hear or speak from the spirit for God without the presence of God, which we have in the new covenant as the presence of the Holy Ghost in us. Glory to God.

Then, as he was taken to the valley of dry bones, he was able to see, in other words, he received information based on which he could speak, or he perceived a situation on which he was to prophesy. No man is allowed to speak his mind out and claim it is God. Everyone should receive something from God, as you see, hear or feel. Not on your own.

After that, he interacted with God. Prayer.

IF you can pray, you can prophesy. If you can speak to God, you can speak on behalf of God.
