#### **Exploratory study**

- 12 interviews with women:
  - 2 with the 99 year-old survivors
  - 8 with the daughters of survivors
  - 2 with the granddaughters of survivors

#### **Duration**

2019 - middle of 2021

> than 40 hours of interviews


