
- 1. Tatters (Noun): Small pieces of something Tattered (Adj): broken into pieces, ruined

 - Syn: Unequivocal, Unambiguous, definite





- To say/ present/ put something firmly
- o **Postulate** (Noun): A pre-approved logic, a theorem taken as true
- Syn = Axiom (Noun), Pre-suppose (Verb), Hypothesize (Verb),
 Theorize (Verb), Posit (Verb)
