

Top 6 Best Vodka Brands In Australia



Vodka is not everybody's first favourite spirit for sipping right away, but it makes a sparkling cocktail or mixer. Now there are a lot and one distinctive kind and flavours to pick from, so let's get to know the best vodkas in Australia.

Smirnoff No. 21 Vodka

Made in Russia in 1864, Smirnoff vodka continues to be the world's top seller for its easy-drinking feel and indifferent flavour profile (it is distilled three times and filtered ten times) that lets it pair easily in any cocktail. If you are considering a do-it-all, Smirnoff vodka will never let you down, this bottle can't be overtaken.

Absolut

While you may not consider a mainstay vodka like Absolut as coming with a locally collected pedigree, the vodka tries to craft all that from the wheat and water that moves into the distillation to the glass bottles it packs in from around its base in southern Sweden. Their ultra-luxe Elyx collection is even gathered from grains from a separate estate and distilled manually in an old copper still to make an extra-smooth spirit that's ideal for martinis and other vodka-forward cocktail preparations.





Belvedere Vodka

While the strong debate over who actually came up with vodka (the Polish or the Russians) rages on, this Polish approach exactly deserves a place in your freezer. Crafted from Dankowskie Gold rye and distilled four times, this ultra-premium vodka is the interpretation of the word "smooth."



Ketel One Vodka

Excited by three centuries of Dutch group distilling culture, this wheat vodka is made using a combo of contemporary column distillation and the coal-fired copper stills for which the vodka is named. An impression of citrus and just a bit of sweetness lead to a deep finish that's a match for any number of typical vodka cocktails.



Tito's Handmade Vodka

Made in Austin, in Texas's first legitimate distillery since Prohibition, this corn-based vodka employs the simple pot still means — an oddity on the vodka scene. The flavour is kind of sweet with a black pepper note that offsets things out whether you are asking for a cocktail that is on the sweet part or skews savoury.



Grey Goose

Grey Goose is an exquisitely smooth vodka that you can sip on its own or whip up a standard Grey Goose Cosmo or Vodka Martini with. This vodka has very citrusy tinges which are mostly why it is a bit smoother to drink effortlessly than many other vodkas out there.

It is costly, sure, but if you aren't a fan of the more strident kick that many vodkas serve to the taste buds, then Grey Goose is one of the most exceptional easy-drinking vodkas you'll get on the supermarket counters.
