PAIN MANAGEMENT PERSONAL STATEMENT SAMPLE

Despite the numerous advances in medicine and science over the centuries, pain is still one of the least understood. Through anesthesia, we can suppress the feeling of paint during major operations, but the underlying causes of individual pains are still not very well understood. For many, the pain stems from a physical source, but for others, sensation of pain might stem from more of a mental source, such as the triggering of memories that leads to a physical sensation. I became very interested in the study and treatment of pain during my medical studies, and hope to continue to specialize in the field through this Pain Management Residency Program.

Psychiatry has always been of interest to me due to the fact that the breadth of knowledge in the field is still very limited. During medical school, I conducted research in pain receptors in mouse models, identifying the source of learned pain and locating it to a single neuron. In the clinic, I worked with patients to identify possible sources of their pain, as well as examined them to find other underlying conditions that pain could be indicated for. Through these experiences, I have learned to better appreciate the tools available for diagnosis of these diseases, and hope to carry my knowledge into my residency training.

This Pain Management residency program will give me the opportunity to harness my deep interest in the field of psychiatry as well as my medical skills in the treatment and management of chronic pain. Through observing and working under the mentorship of skilled psychiatrists, I will be able to learn new patient interviewing techniques, as well as the types of technology available to help assess patterns and activity in the neurological systems. SAMPLE PERSONAL STATEMENT ADDICTION PSYCHIATRY

The opioid crisis is growing exponentially in this country, and many lawmakers have already called on the government to take more actions in helping to stem the flow of addictive substances into communities. However, as a student of the sciences, I also know that part of the reason behind the growing epidemic is a psychological dependence on the substances, grown from both a physical need as well as altered states of mental function. My community was struck hard by opioid addiction, and it inspired me to pursue a career in medicine in order to help people break the cycle of addiction. Through this residency in Addiction Psychiatry, I hope to gain new insight into techniques to help patients quit their habits and pursue healthy lives.

As part of my psychiatry rotation, I worked at an off-site location that was originally a clinic for depression, but had been turned into a treatment center for addiction due to the sheer number of patients. During my time in the rotation, I worked with many patients to provide both medical support and a compassionate ear to listen to their stories. I learned how to take a full patient history based on oral interviews, as well as order lab testing to determine the correct dose of synthetic anti-addiction medication that would gradually wean them off opioids. This experience greatly touched me, and has solidified my dedication towards helping to treat addiction.

This residency program in Addiction Psychiatry will help me to better understand the motives and mental processes that drive addiction so that proper treatment can be administered. Through working with experienced psychiatrists in the field, I will gain experience in diagnosing underlying psychiatric issues while also treating addiction through both mental and physical therapy.
