Sam thinks for a minute.

IMAGE: JOSH WASHINGTON, SMILING.

Sam nods.

SAM

Of course.

Judging by her face, she's not fully convinced.

SAM

HANNAH

SAM

HANNAH

(smiles)

Really? That's what I'm going to tell Mike.

Sam's confused.

HANNAH

SAM

(speechless)

Sam takes a deep breath.

The tattoo artist comes back, gives Hannah her change.

HANNAH

See you later, Lizzy.

(to Sam)

MATCH CUT TO:

EXT. MOUNTAIN - 10:00 PM

A POSTER, PINNED ON A TREE, with Hannah's photo, barely holding on. It says, with big bold letters: "HAVE YOU SEEN HER?"

The poster flies away, carried by the wind.

EXT. LODGE, ENTRANCE - 10:00 PM

NINE HOURS UNTIL DAWN.

EMILY knocks on the lodge's door. JOSH opens it.

TOSH

Hey! Come in.

EMILY

Hi, thanks.

Emily enters the lodge.

INT. LODGE, MAIN HALL - 10:01 PM

SAM, ASHLEY, CHRIS AND MATT are there.

Matt goes and hugs Emily.

MATT

Finally, I was worried about you.

Emily pushes him away.

EMILY

Jeez, Matt, we saw each other, like, ten minutes ago.

MATT

You took your time. I was afraid you got lost.

EMILY

Well, I'm here, so, relax, okay?

SAM

EMILY

What?

(pause)

Oh, yeah, you're right, but we can talk later.

MATT

I thought you said it was important.

EMILY

It is, but I rather talk in private.

Matt nods.

SAM

Whenever you want.

JESS and MIKE enter the lodge.

Heeeey!

JOSH

What's up?

Emily scoffs, Jess ignores it.

MIKE

Are we getting this party going or what?!

JOSH

Yeah, man! Beers are in the fridge, and--

(to Jess)

Jess, you brought the speakers, right?

Jess takes one out of her bag.

JESS

Here it is.

JOSH

Great, thanks.

MIKE

I'll bring the drinks. Who's up for a cold beer?

CHRIS

I'll take one.

MIKE

On it.

JESS

Wait for me!

Mike and Jess go to the kitchen.

CHRIS

You never had alcohol, Ash?

ASHLEY

I don't see the appeal.

CHRIS

Good, I need you to stay sober so you can look after me.

ASHLEY

(smiles)

Don't count on it.

Emily takes her cellphone out, annoyed.

EMILY

Ugh, this stupid speaker --

MATT

What?

EMILY

I can't connect to this goddamn thing.

Jess and Mike come back, smiling. They carry several BOTTLES AND CUPS.

EMILY

(to Jess)

Hey, what's up with this crap?

JESS

(annoyed)

What do you mean?

EMILY

Does this thing have bluetooth, or--?

Mike and Jess leave the bottles and cups on a table.

JESS

Obviously.

EMILY

Well, it's not working.

JESS

I'm already connected, maybe that's why.

EMILY

Of course that's why.

(whispers)

Dumbass.

JESS

What did you just say?

EMILY

Are you putting some music on or not?

Jess tunes in some POP MUSIC.

Emily rolls her eyes.

Chris and Josh go for a drink, with Mike and Jess.

Sam walks around the house, Matt sits on a couch, and Emily just looks at Chris, Mike and Jess.

JESS

No, no, that's too much! (laughs)

Mike!

MIKE

Oh, come on! Have some fun!

They both laugh.

Sam looks through a window. The snow falls peacefully on the trees...

ASHLEY

Everything alright?

SAM

Yeah, I'm fine. I just... Need to relax.

ASHLEY

I get that.

(pause)

You know, the bathroom has a giant tub.

Sam smiles.

SAM

I could use a hot bath right now.

Jess and Mike keep laughing, and they KISS.

EMILY

Okay, is this how it's gonna be the whole weekend or what? Because I don't know how much more I can take.

Jess ignores her.

MATT

Em...

EMILY

I'm serious! Could they be any more disgusting?

Jess looks at her.

JESS

And could you be any more obvious?

EMILY

(scoffs)

What are you talking about?

Guys, come on...

EMILY

Shut up, Matt!

JESS

(looks at Mike)

Sounds like someone's bitter she didn't make the cut.

(points at Matt)

Look at him! He's her puppet. You're using him to make Mike jealous, honey?

MATT

Jess, come on...

EMILY

Oh, yeah, totally! You're Mike's girlfriend. Congratulations! Now, you can add his name to your sleep list!

Jess smiles mockingly.

EMILY

You should leave some space for your future bosses' names. Because, let's be honest, you're not getting too far with your grades.

JESS

Why should I care about grades when I've got all the natural advantages you can barely manage?

EMILY

Are you serious?

JESS

(angry)

You couldn't even work as a stripper with that flat ass.

Emily laughs.

EMILY

Really? Do you think that's insulting?

JESS

Whatever. I don't give a crap what you say.

EMILY

At least I--

JOSH

STOP IT! You guys are -- Gosh! You got here five minutes ago! This is not what I had planned!

JESS

I'm truly sorry Josh, but if she doesn't back off, then--

JOSH

Maybe we should take a break, okay? Mike, why don't you go check out that cabin I told you about?

MIKE

Uh, yeah, sure.

(to Jess)

Let's go, babe.

Jess and Emily stare at each other, menacingly.

JESS

Yes.

Jess kisses Mike in front of Emily, and they leave.

JOSH

Finally.

Josh clears his throat.

JOSH

Uh, guys, why don't you go check out your rooms and all that stuff?

EMILY

Let's go, Matt. I want the best one!

Matt's clearly embarrased for what just had happened.

EMILY

Wait... Where's my bag?

MATT

What?

EMILY

My bag! The purple one!

MATT

There was no purple bag.

EMILY

Are you freaking kidding me?! Jesus!

Everyone looks at Matt. Sam gives him a condemned look.

EMILY

You must have left it by the cable car station.

MATT

I left it?

EMILY

Who carried the bags? Huh?

Matt doesn't respond.

EMILY

Come on! We'll be back soon.

Matt sighs.

MATT

Fine. Let's go.

(to the rest)

We'll be quick.

The rest doesn't say anything. The couple leaves.

JOSH

I guess it's just us then.

SAM

I'm sorry.

JOSH

It's not your fault.

(cheering up)

Hey, we got a whole weekend here! Let's have some fun!

CHRIS

What's on your mind?

JOSH

I know that somewhere around here we had a... What are those things called? Oh, right, a spirit board.

CHRIS

(skeptical)

Spirit board?

ASHLEY

(excited)

Seriously? Where?

JOSH

I don't know. Hey, why don't you two go find it?

CHRIS

I don't know, man, those things don't do shit.

ASHLEY

Come on, Chris! It'll be like a
treasure hunt!

Ashley goes upstairs. Josh smiles at Chris.

He groans, rushes up behind Ash.

JOSH

They'll find a way to have fun.

SAM

Are you playing matchmaker?

JOSH

SLAM--

 $\mbox{--Mike}$ closes the door to the lodge. He puts his arm around Jess, and they start walking.

JESS

So, where are we off to, captain?

MIKE

The most romantic, coziest cabin you'll ever lay your eyes upon.

JESS

We'll see about that. How far is it, anyway?

MIKE

Who cares? It's just you and me. Time to have fun.

JESS

Finally, now that we're free from that bitch.

MIKE

You've been five minutes together.

JESS

Five minutes too long. I'm not letting anyone or anything ruin our weekend.

Mike sighs.

MIKE

Just ignore her. She's still kinda bummed because I dumped her.

JESS

So? Not my problem, Mike, and not yours either. Why do we have to put up with her shitty attitude?

MIKE

Yeah, maybe you're right. Screw her.

JESS

(smiles)

Now we're talking.

Jess looks at the landscape: the quiet mountains, covered in snow...

JESS

Wow. It's like a real wonderland out here.

(to Mike)

Hey, handsome, selfie? We haven't taken a good picture in weeks!

MIKE

We got that one on the fortune wheel.

JESS

Ugh, don't even get me started on that one. Come on!

Jess and Mike pose.

CLICK!

The couple looks at the photo.

JESS

Heck yeah, aren't we hot? And on the first try!

MIKE

We're naturals.

Jess laughs, they continue following the road.

EXT. PATH TO THE CABLE CAR STATION - 10:14 PM

Emily and Matt walk silently.

EMILY

She's a pain in the ass.

MATT

What?

EMILY

Jessica, miss homecoming, the prom queen. She thinks she's better than everyone else just because she's dating the class prez. What an idiot, right?

MATT

I don't understand what's your problem with her.

EMILY

Are you blind, Matt? They were all, like, touchy and stuff. I mean, no one wants to see that.

MATT

Sounded like it was more than that.

EMILY

What do you mean?

MATT

Nothing.

(pause)

Have you talked to Sam yet?

EMILY

Uh, no, I'll talk to her later. Don't worry.

MATT

Emily, are you lying to me?

Emily stops.

EMILY

What?

MATT

I know you didn't go after Sam. What did you do?

EMILY

What are you talking about?

MATT

Emily...

EMILY

Listen, I was looking for Sam, and Mike and I happened to run into each other. It was a while since we've seen each other so we had a lot to catch up on. That's all.

MATT

Of course. Mike.

EMILY

Matt, nothing happened! Why don't you trust me?

MATT

Then why did you hide it from me?

EMILY

Because I knew you would get all like this.

Emily smiles, touches Matt's shoulder.

EMILY

You're kinda territorial over me, and I like that.

Matt eases up.

MATT

Okay, okay, we still got a bag to find.

EMILY

Once we do I'll think of a reward for you. I owe you one, remember?

Matt slightly smiles.

INT. LODGE, BASEMENT - 10:20 PM

Sam and Josh walk down the stairs to the basement. Josh carries a FLASHLIGHT.

JOSH

Hey, Sammy.

SAM

Yeah?

Josh stops. He looks at Sam.

JOSH

I just -- I wanted to thank you.

SAM

Thank me? For what?

JOSH

You know, for coming here. I really appreciate it.

SAM

Josh--

JOSH

No, seriously. You don't know how much this means to me.

Sam smiles pitifully.

JOSH

I know this is hard for you, coming back up here. It's weird, I get it. But I just want you to understand why I'm doing this.

SAM

Josh, you don't have to explain yourself. We're all very sorry for what happened last year, that's why we're here.

JOSH

I knew you'd understand, Sam. I'm really glad you all came. Specially you.

SAM

Anything you need, I'm here for you. We're all here for you. Don't be ashamed of reaching out for help sometimes, okay?

JOSH

I'm aware I haven't been really...
Present, this last year. I'm sorry.

SAM

Don't apologize. It's understandable.

JOSH

You've always been really good to me, Sam. And to my sisters, too. I can't thank you enough.

Sam smiles slightly.

Josh smiles back, he continues to walk down the stairs.

Sam's smile dissolves into a troubled look...

INT. LODGE, UPPER FLOOR - 10:22 PM

Chris and Ashley look through the basement. There's BOOKSHELVES, filled with all sorts of stuff.

ASHLEY

It's like a flea market here.

Ashley grabs a DOLL'S FACE, without it's eyes.

ASHLEY

What even is this?

Chris keeps looking through the bookshelves.

CHRIS

Must be all from Josh's dad, for sure.

ASHLEY

Oh, like his movie props?

CHRIS

Yep.

Chris finds a TROPHY, in the shape of a camera.

CHRIS

Check this out...

(reading)

Best Horror Movie: House of

Madness, 2012.

(to Ashley)

Have you seen it?

Ashley shakes her head.

ASHLEY

Not really into horror.

CHRIS

I thought you said you loved paranormal stuff.

ASHLEY

Yes, because those things are in real life, not movies.

CHRIS

Real life? Have you ever seen a ghost?

ASHLEY

Isn't that why we're looking for that spirit board?

Chris smiles.

CHRIS

Just don't tell Josh you didn't see his dad's movies. He'll make you watch them one after the other, trust me.

ASHLEY

(chuckles)

Gotcha.

They both keep looking.

EXT. PATH TO THE CABIN - 10:26 PM

Jess and Mike walk through the frozen forest, side by side.

JESS

Now THIS is a holiday.

MIKE

I knew you'd like it.

JESS

It's freezing out here, though.

MIKE

That's why I'm here.

Mike puts his arm around Jess.

MIKE

Better?

JESS

Aha.

They both smile, keep walking.

Jess TRIPS, AND FALLS.

MIKE

Jess, are you okay?!

JESS

I'm fine, I'm fine.

Jess grunts, stands up with Mike's help. Jess looks at what made her fall: a TAPE with yellow and black stripes.

JESS

What the hell?

She follows the tape, sees it TIED to a tree. Old, rusty, but still holding on.

JESS

Police tape? Is that --?

MIKE

From Hannah and Beth? Yeah, I guess so.

JESS

You'd think they'd clean it up...

MIKE

Well, the investigation's not over. They're still missing.

JESS

Not over? You see any cops looking for them?

MIKE

Jess, come on.

JESS

I'm serious. Everyone's given up, including us. They're dead because of our prank.

MIKE

(scoffs)

Jess, who would've known they'd run into the woods!?

JESS

That's not the point. They went there because of us. We basically killed them.

MIKE

Don't say that! They're not dead, they're missing!

JESS

You know, Mike, people that are missing for a year tend to stay that way.

Jess leaves, Mike breathes deeply...

BEGIN FLASHBACK.

INT. POLICE STATION - NIGHT - FLASHBACK

Mike sits nervously on a chair. It's an empty room besides from a ONE-WAY WINDOW. A woman dressed as a doctor enters the room.

The teenager looks down, doesn't dare to raise his head.

PSYCHIATRIST

Laura sits across from Mike.

PSYCHIATRIST

Your friends already spoke about what happened, Michael, but it's really important for us to get every version of it. Do you understand?

Mike doesn't speak. His eyes are red due to excessive crying.

PSYCHIATRIST

It's no use to blame yourself. You need to understand that some things are beyond your control. The girls chose to run into those woods, they were aware of the risks that meant, but they still did it.

(pause)

Why they did it, that's a whole other story. The one we want to hear from you, specially, Michael. Please, colaborate.

Mike starts to get agitated.

MIKE

I-- I don't--

PSYCHIATRIST

Breathe, take your time. I can understand how hard it is. If you need to vent, this is the moment.

Mike starts crying again.

PSYCHIATRIST

I'll be here for when you're ready to talk. It's just you and me, okay?

Mike keeps looking down.

The woman looks at the one-way window, breathes deeply, and shakes her head.

END FLASHBACK.

EXT. PATH TO THE CABLE CAR STATION - 10:25 PM

Matt and Emily go through a wooden structure.

EMILY

(tired)

How much longer?

MATT

Ten minutes at least.

Emily stops and sits down.

MATT

Fifteen if you do that.

EMILY

I need a break. Come here.

Matt sits next to Emily. She cuddles next to him.

EMILY

(breathing deeply)

Isn't this place beautiful?

MATT

(dry)

Yep.

EMILY

What's wrong?

MATT

Why did you and Mike break up?

Emily stops cuddling.

EMILY

Matt, what's up with you and Mike?

MATT

What's up with YOU and Mike?

Emily doesn't respond.

MATT

I just wanted to know why you guys broke up. That's all.

EMILY

Honestly, I can't remember. Probably a stupid fight, we had a lot of those.

Matt nods.

EMILY

But that's all in the past now.

MATT

Aha.

Emily looks at Matt, who's not fully convinced, and sighs.

EMILY

You know what I have in that bag we're looking for?

MATT

Your cellphone charger?

EMILY

That, some clothes, and something else.

Matt looks at her, intrigued.

MATT

Well, what could that be?

EMILY

Something that'll take us on a wild trip.

MATT

Oh, really?

EMILY

Hell yeah!

Emily smiles.

MATT

EMILY

INT. LODGE, BASEMENT - 10:30 PM

Josh and Sam go through the basement, filled with BOOKSHELVES full of all types of props.

JOSH

Welcome to my dad's hoarding basement.

SAM

(chuckles)

What's all this?

JOSH

Dad's movie stuff. You'll find all sorts of junk in here.

Sam looks through the bookshelves: fake eyeballs in a jar, dusty dolls, a set of fake knives.

SAM

You can really tell what genre of movies he does.

JOSH

(laughs)

Yeah, imagine coming down here by yourself.

SAM

Hard pass.

Sam stumbles onto a TENNIS RACKET. In it's handle, it says WASHINGTON, '17

SAM

What movie's this from?

JOSH

That's not a prop, silly.
(MORE)

JOSH (cont'd)

(takes the racket)

It was Hannah's. My dad bought it for her when she got bronze in--

SAM

--The regionals under 18 tournament. I remember, I was there.

JOSH

Oh, right.

(laughs)

She was so pissed off that day.

SAM

Yeah, that point was totally out, it didn't even touch the line! Oh my God, her face when she lost.

JOSH

She was pretty good for her age. A champion in our hearts, am I right?

SAM

(laughs)

Yeah, of course.

Josh stares at the racket.

JOSH

(melancholic)

She was pretty good indeed...

(looks at Sam)

Can't live in the past, right, Sam? Gotta look always forward.

Sam doesn't say anything.

JOSH

Anyway, I should be fixing your boiler, else you'll be taking a bath next year! Follow me.

Sam looks preocupied. She follows Josh.

EXT. LOOKOUT SPOT - 10:34 PM

Jess and Mike arrive to a lookout spot with a TELESCOPE.

Jess stops, looks at Mike.

JESS

Mike, I'm sorry about before. I was angry and--

MIKE

You don't have to apologize. I understand.

(pause)

Coming back here is more difficult than I thought.

Jess nods.

JESS

I wish I could be as positive as you are. They are technically still missing.

MIKE

Technically, yes.

They remain silent.

JESS

I killed the mood, didn't I?

Mike breathes deeply, he smiles.

MIKE

Nah, don't worry about it.

(pause)

Come on, let's stop thinking about it.

JESS

Yeah, you're right. I need a distraction.

MIKE

(points at the telescope) I see a telescope right there. Wanna check it out?

Jess smiles, looks through the telescope.

TELESCOPE VIEW:

The trees look all zoomed in, and the CABIN is there.

JESS

I see the cabin. It's uh... A bit smaller than I thought it'd be.

MIKE

Well, then I guess we're going to have to be very tight.

JESS

Really smooth, Mike.

Jess keeps looking at the cabin--

-- SOMETHING RUNS PAST IT.

Jess screams, startled.

MIKE

What's wrong!?

JESS

Jesus! That scared me.

Mike starts laughing.

MIKE

You scared me! What happened?

JESS

I just-- A freaking deer just jumped out of nowhere.

MIKE

(still laughing)

A deer? Are you sure?

JESS

Yes, I'm sure! What else could've been?

MIKE

I don't know, maybe... A bear!

Mike ROARS, Jess rolls her eyes.

JESS

Very funny.

MIKE

Alright, come on, we still have a long time to go.

JESS

I'm starting to doubt this is worth it.

MIKE

I'll prove to you it isn't once we get there.

JESS

Oh, and how are you gonna do that?

MIKE

You'll see.

Mike smiles, flirty. The couple continues their walk.

INT. LODGE, MAIN FLOOR - 10:38 PM

Chris and Ashley go down the stairs.

ASHLEY

I'm starting to doubt this board even exists.

CHRIS

If you're scared just say it, Ash. I won't judge you.

Ashley smiles.

ASHLEY

I'm terrified, Chris.

CHRIS

It's gotta be in the basement.

ASHLEY

(sighs)

Of course it's in the basement.

CHRIS

I'm hungry.

ASHLEY

Shocker.

CHRIS

Wanna go eat something first?

ASHLEY

I could, actually.

CHRIS

Come on, I'll make you my specialty.

INT. LODGE, KITCHEN - 10:40 PM

A KNIFE spreads peanut butter over some bread.

CHRIS

Hell yeah.

ASHLEY

That's your specialty? Are you serious?

CHRIS

I'm not done yet.

Ashley smiles and sits on the chair, while she looks at Chris, focused on his meal.

CHRIS

Some bananas...

Chris opens the fridge, takes two bananas out.

ASHLEY

Hey, how's Josh doing? Did he tell you anything?

Chris sighs, starts slicing the banana.

CHRIS

He didn't. We didn't speak a lot last year. The fact that he began to be homeschooled didn't help.

ASHLEY

So all of this... You didn't expect he was going to do this.

CHRIS

(shakes his head)

It was a surprise to me too. Last time I had heard of him he was seeing a psychiatrist, taking meds...

ASHLEY

How long was this?

CHRIS

A couple months ago. He stopped replying and after a while I stopped reaching out, too.

ASHLEY

Weird...

CHRIS

I don't want to bring anything up. He seems to be doing better, and I'd like to keep it that way.

ASHLEY

I'm just worried, you know? We're here for him and these guys can't get along for five minutes.

CHRIS

Yeah, I know.

ASHLEY

I don't know why he invited Jessica and Emily. It's always drama when those two share the room.

CHRIS

Girls, am I right?

Ashley stares at him. Chris drops the knife.

CHRIS

I mean-- Mike and Matt can be pretty annoying too.

Ashley doesn't respond.

CHRIS

CHRIS

(pissed off)

EMILY

As soon as we find my bag, we're going back to the lodge and calling the cops. They might find a clue, or something!

TTAM

You think? This thing's dead.

EMILY

Maybe it just needs to be charged. We'll see at the lodge.

MATT

We should go back now.

EMILY

No way I'm going back without my bag. We're almost there, come on!

Emily walks away, Matt keeps the cellphone in his pocket.

INT. LODGE, BASEMENT - 10:43 PM

Sam and Josh arrive to the boiler.

JOSH

Here we go, let's see...

Sam lights the basement with her flashlight. No one's there.

Josh presses some buttons.

JOSH

Gotta get the water pressure going...

SAM

This place is so creepy.

JOSH

Why'd you think I asked you to come down with me?

Sam chuckles.

SAM

Just give me some hot water and I'll be super fine.

JOSH

Okay, almost done.

Sam walks through the basement. She points her flashlight at a WINE CELLAR. Far over, another door.

SAM

Hey, you got a wine cellar down here?

JOSH (O.S)

Pretty rad, right? It's empty, though. My parents took them back home.

SAM

And what's on the other side?

JOSH (O.S)

Not sure. My parents kept that door locked.

SAM

And it never occured to you to check?

JOSH (O.S)

Not really.

SAM

Huh.

Sam wanders off, keeps walking through the stacked bookshelves.

She notices a DOLL HOUSE, standing on a desk. Intrigued, she gets closer.

SAM

What do we have here?

Sam peeks through the little window--

-- FWOOSH, water starts to go through the pipes very loudly.

Sam flinches.

JOSH (O.S)

Sorry!

She sighs in relief.

SAM

Did something just explode?

JOSH (O.S)

(chuckles)

The boiler's a little rusty. But you got your hot water!

Sam goes with Josh.

JOSH

(smiles, mockingly)

Did I scare you?

SAM

Of course not.

JOSH

Yeah, sure.

SAM

You startled me, those are two completely different things.

JOSH

Aha, right.

Sam scoffs, goes to the stairs.

SAM

You coming or not?

JOSH

I think I know where the spirit board is. I'll go look for it, I don't think Chris and Ash found it.

SAM

Okay.

Sam goes upstairs.

INT. LODGE, KITCHEN - 10:45 PM

Chris and Ash sit side by side, each one of them eating Chris' specialty.

CHRIS

(smiles)

It's not so bad after all, huh?

ASHLEY

(covers her full mouth)

I never said it was bad, just simple.

CHRIS

Simple can be good sometimes.

Ash nods.

THE TELEPHONE'S VOICE RECORDER PLAYS.

RECORDING

One message unread.

(pause)

Playing message now.

CHRIS

What the hell?

A MALE VOICE TALKS IN THE KITCHEN.

TENNANT (V.O)

Hi, Mrs. Washington, it's sargeant Tennant again.

CHRIS

Did you touch anything?

Ashley shakes her head, confused.

TENNANT (V.O)

It's bad news I'm afraid. We've looked through the files and...
There's nothing we can do, legally.

CHRIS

It's coming from the telephone--

ASHLEY

Shh. Listen.

TENNANT (V.O)

He hasn't done anything. He's a free man. However, if you're still worried, I can maybe arrange some more procedures, but I can't assure you I'll be able to.

(pause)

I know this might be upsetting, so call me if you have any more questions. See you later.

Pause, silence.

RECORDING

End of message.

CLICK.

CHRIS

What was that all about?

ASHLEY

That was sent to Josh's mom. How old is that message?

CHRIS

And why did it play right now?

ASHLEY

You think we should tell Josh?

CHRIS

No, no, that's a bad idea. Think about it, the Washingtons haven't been here since last year. This is probably super old, it surely isn't that important. We shouldn't worry Josh over nothing.

ASHLEY

Yeah, you're right. He's gone through enough shit already.

CHRIS

(nodding)

Let's just forget we heard that.

They continue eating, silently.

EXT. PATH TO THE CABIN - 10:48 PM

Jess is starting to get a bit impatient.

JESS

How much farther Mike? I'm already too tired to do anything else, if you know what I mean.

MIKE

Jess, come on, relax. Enjoy the view!

JESS

I've been doing that for the last hour. I have nothing against nature, but I have a limit, Mike, and it was already surpassed.

MIKE

Okay, what do you want me to do?

JESS

Nothing.

MIKE

Come on! Tell me!

JESS

(annoyed)

Nothing, Mike, seriously. I'll have to come up with something to not die of boredom and fatigue.

Mike sighs.

HEAT VISION: SOMETHING LURKING BEHIND THE TREES, STALKING JESS AND MIKE.

JESS

So, once we get to the cabin, I'm going to--

A deer JUMPS RIGHT IN FRONT OF JESS, RUNS OFF.

JESS

Holy shit!

MIKE

Oh my God, Jess, are you okay!?

JESS

I told you there were fucking deer around here! That thing almost killed me!

MIKE

Stay close to me. We're sticking together.

JESS

Yeah, that's a good idea.

HEAT VISION: THE STALKER KEEPS PREYING ONTO THE COUPLE.

MIKE

That adrenaline must've taken the boredom out of you, huh?

Jess gives Mike a death stare.

MIKE

Too soon?

INT. LODGE, MAIN HALL - 10:50 PM

Sam walks up into the main hall.

SAM

Chris?

No one responds.

SAM

Ashley? You guys here?

Nothing. Sam notices the kitchen door a bit open, she goes in.

INT. LODGE, KITCHEN - 10:50 PM

Sam enters the kitchen.

SAM

Guys?

NO ONE'S THERE.

SAM

Where the hell are these two?

CHRIS JUMPS FROM BEHIND THE DOOR AND SCREAMS AT THE TOP OF HIS LUNGS!

SAM

JESUS CHRIST!

Chris starts laughing hysterically.

SAM

What is wrong with you!?

Sam hits Chris in the shoulder repeatedly.

CHRIS

Ow, ow, OW!

Ashley walks in the kitchen.

ASHLEY

You kinda had that coming.

Sam looks at Ashley.

ASHLEY

Sorry, he forbade me to warn you.

Sam sighs.

CHRIS

Should've filmed that. It was awesome.

SAM

What were you guys doing here?

CHRIS

Uh, we got hungry, so I made us my specialty: peanut banana sandwich. You want one?

SAM

No thanks.

(pause)

What happened to the "treasure hunt"?

ASHLEY

That spirit board doesn't exist. We searched everywhere upstairs.

CHRIS

Where's Josh?

SAM

Well, he was looking for the spirit board in the basement.

CHRIS

You're not gonna believe what just happened to us.

ASHLEY

Chris! I thought we were not telling anyone!

SAM

What? Tell anyone what?

CHRIS

We said we couldn't tell Josh. This is Sam.

SAM

Guys, what's going on?

Ashley sighs.

CHRIS

We heard this message, it was from some kind policeman, at least that's what we think.

ASHLEY

He said his name was sargeant Tennant. He has to be a police guy.

CHRIS

Anyway, the message said something about a guy, and that he was a free man, and there was nothing they could do.

SAM

Who?

ASHLEY

We've no idea, but if Josh's mom was so worried about him as to call the police...

SAM

It can't be good. What do you think it means?

CHRIS

We're not sure. We just assumed it was old.

SAM

Yeah, that's very likely. I mean--

ASHLEY

Josh!

Josh enters the kitchen.

JOSH

What are you guys doing in here?

ASHLEY

Nothing, it doesn't matter.

JOSH

Did someone scream in here before?

CHRIS

(smiles)

I scared Sam.

ASHLEY

Startled, actually.

SAM

Thank you, Ash.

JOSH

(smiles)

Nice!

SAM

Yeah, very nice.

CHRIS

Did you find the spirit board?

Josh shows them a OUIJA BOARD in his hand, triumphant.

JOSH

Here's our one way ticket to the spirit realm. Shall we?

SAM

Oh, no, I've been through enough spooking for one night. I'll be relaxing in a nice hot bath while you deal with angry ghosts.

CHRIS

Your loss.

SAM

You guys have fun.

Sam goes upstairs.

JOSH

(smiling)

Who's ready?

Through the window, A MAN SPIES ON THE TEENAGERS.

He has some GOGGLES, a FLAMETHROWER AND A MACHETE, HANGED ON HIS BACK.

We hear his muffled breathing, and see everything through his point of view.

He spies breafly, and then leaves.

EXT. PATH TO THE CABIN - 10:52 PM

A LOUD SCREECH, RESONATING THROUGH THE MOUNTAIN.

JESS

Mike? What was that?

MIKE

I'm not sure. I heard it before, though, when we were going to the lodge.

JESS

Well, what do you think it is?

MIKE

It's gotta be an animal, right?

JESS

What kind of animal screams like that?

MIKE

I -- I don't know, I didn't really
pay attention in bio class.

JESS

Me neither. Kinda wish I did now.

MIKE

Jess, you're still freaked out over that deer thing, alright? Just take a deep breath. Everything's gonna be fine.

Jess forcedly smiles.

JESS

Yeah, you're right, you're right. Gotta cool off.

MIKE

I can help you with that.

Mike places his arm around Jess, and smiles. They keep walking.

EXT. PATH TO THE CABLE CAR STATION - 10:54 PM

Emily and Matt walk silently.

Matt fidgets with Beth's phone in his pocket...

BEGIN FLASHBACK.

EXT. STREET - NIGHT - FLASHBACK

Matt and Beth stroll around a quiet street. They're both smiling, shyly.

BETH

Thanks for walking me home. You didn't have to.

MATT

Josh would kill me if I didn't.

BETH

(chuckles)

That's probably true.

MATT

And also... I wanted to spend as much time as I could with you before you left.

BETH

It's just a week. But, I'll see you again there over the weekend, right?

MATT

Of course, I wouldn't miss Hannah's long awaited party.

BETH

You don't know how excited she is. She talks about it every day.

(chuckles)

It's gonna be fun.

MATT

(smiles)

It will.

Beth stops at a door.

BETH

Here it is. Thank you, again.

MATT

No problem, really. My pleasure.

Beth takes out a set of keys, walks up to the door.

BETH

See you in a week, then.

MATT

See you later.

They both nod and smile, a little bit awkwardly.

Beth runs to Matt, gives him a quick kiss. They smile.

BETH

See you then.

Beth enters the house. Matt leaves, with a huge smile in his face.

END FLASHBACK.

EXT. PATH TO THE CABLE CAR STATION - 10:56 PM

A tear streams down Matt's face.

EMILY

Matt, are you listening!?

Matt wakes up as if he had been walking asleep.

EMILY

Look at that!

Emily points to a RIPPED PURPLE SWEATER, COVERED IN SNOW. She runs and checks on it.

EMILY

This is mine! My beautiful, expensive H&M sweater!

MATT

I don't-- I don't understand, how
did it end here?

EMILY

Damned if I know! It was in my bag!

MATT

(worried)

What bag, exactly?

EMILY

The purple one with--

MATT

Is it the same one we're looking for?

Emily nods. Matt looks around, alert.

EMILY

Someone did this, and tore this apart!

MATT

Or something...

EMILY

Let's spread out, see if we find something else. I'm gonna kill the shithead that did this.

The couple spreads out. They go into the woods, leaving the path.

EMILY

This goddamn mountain... I should've never brought a sweater like that...

Emily makes her way through naked white tree branches.

EMILY

(sighs)

Nothing.

MATT (O.S)
EMILY! COME LOOK AT THIS!

Emily runs back to where Matt went...

She finds him with a terrified look.

EMILY

What's wrong?

Matt holds a DESTROYED LEATHER VEST.

Emily takes the vest into her own hands.

EMILY

Oh my God! What!?

MATT

That's not the worst part.

EMILY

What's the worst--

Ahead, she notices a purple bag...

EMILY

Oh no...

It has been completely TORN APART, with clothes all ripped off and spread out everywhere.

EMILY

WHAT THE FU--

EXT. PATH TO THE CABIN - 10:57 PM

Mike goes to a tree.

MTKE

Hey Jess, come here.

Mike picks up a sharp rock, starts scribbling the tree.

He writes: "M + J", and then draws a heart.

Mike smiles.

MIKE

I know it's cheesy but...

(turns around)

What?

JESS IS GONE.

MIKE

Jess? Are you here?

No response.

MIKE

(a bit worried)
It's not funny, okay? So why don't
you just--

JESS SCREAMS DESPERATELY IN THE DISTANCE.

THE END
