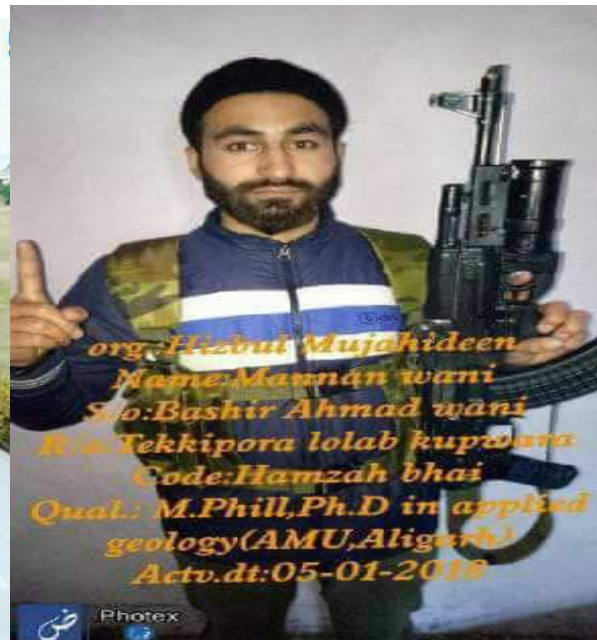

Why should we not link K-Issue with Global Jihad?

What is Jihad? A simple definition of Jihad means 'fighting in the way of Allah'. and what is this "way of Allah"? This has a broad meaning and a wider connotation. To fight for ^{implementation of} supremacy of divine Laws, to liberate mankind from slavery of humans, to fight oppression, tyranny & most important is to fight for the implementation of peace - these all including some other acts are Jihad. But yes Jihad has a conditions & terms too like every other act of Islam has; like the Jihad can be waged by only a practising Muslim and against a non-muslim or a Mustafid or the enemy who has occupied muslim lands or the state which continues to harass & torture muslim citizens. Thus Jihad sometimes turns 'Fard' (obligatory) and sometimes 'Wajib' - based on the conditions i.e. space and Time. The place where the call of Jihad & the time at which the process of Jihad starts became the ultimate and deciding factors while determining the course of action, strategies & the short and long term goals.

There are various ^{resistance} movements going on in the world more especially in Muslim world. The prominent among them are that of Palestine & Kashmir and before that the case study of 'Afghan Jihad' also serves a good example. While I will go in detail about the nature of resistance movements in Kashmir, it would be better if some light is thrown on Afghan Jihad.

When Communist Russians (^{ex-est-while} U.S.S.R.) occupied & colonised Afghanistan, the ^{Tribal fighters, initially} Mujahideen took a call & called for rebellion, the good number of population on seeing the mayhem & destruction created by Communists joined. ~~Later~~ Later on few students from Islamic seminaries joined them & thus it formed into a Taliban Movement. It is important to note that people in Afghanistan are born fighters who hate slavery & they loved their religion & culture, Thus invasion by Russian Communists was seen an attack on their life, culture, resources, autonomy, power & above all religion, which invoked a rebellion. It should be noted that the rebellion was initiated & carried forward by Muslims thus it naturally became a Jihad. Therefore, any resistance, rebellion or movement

fought or initiated by Muslims (who derive their ^{inspiration from Islam} principles from the Holy Quran & their strength from Almighty, ^{Summa} to liberate Muslim lands from occupiers onto establish Shariat (Islam based model of governance) is Jihad.

Coming back to Kashmir issue which has ^{under} gone many ups & downs since the inception of Dogra rule and then after the illegal occupation by Indian forces in 1947. The continuous betrayal by successive regimes of Indian government to let the people of J&K decide their future by their ^{exercising} 'Right to self determination' after partition of United British India. It should be noted down that the K-issue has roots in the partition & the partition, whether anyone ~~see~~ accepts or not was done on the lines of religion, thus ^{erstwhile} ~~K&J&K~~ (Indian occupied Kashmir) Azad Kashmir, Gilgit, Baltistan) comprising of Muslim majority population was naturally a part of newly formed Pakistan, the land ^{state} of Muslims. ~~was~~ But unfortunately, The Brahmanical and Fascist governments in India & the power hungry Communist regimes in ^{J&K} Kashmir betrayed the people of J&K and made an illegal agreement with India against the wishes of majority population, which led to a full fledged resistance movement

against the illegal occupation of J&K by the India. From 1947 to 1988; people of Kashmir tried each and every 'peaceful' method to seek their basic & legitimate right; The right to self determination, to decide their future in between this time, ^{The} Indian government took the Kashmir issue to United nations, but to their dismay the world ~~made~~ made it clear that people of Kashmir should be given a chance to decide their fate - whether they want to live with India or Pakistan & for this purpose more than a dozen resolutions were passed & it was unaminously accepted by India & Pakistan that people of Kashmir are the ultimate authority to decide their future & for that purpose they would be given an opportunity [&] through democratic means in the presence of any UN, they would vote for either of the two countries i.e. India & Pakistan. But again the Brahmanical & Chanakayan politicians of India using their military might denied this right to citizens of Kashmir & used every kind of brute force & inhumane laws to crush every voice seeking this basic right. while Pakistan government continues to state that they are ready for third party intervention & plead before world for the Kashmiri's right to self-

determination, The Indian government on the other hand created proxies, held ~~free~~ farce elections, increased their military presence & began signed illegal agreements with illegitimate rulers of J&K and ^{thus} made a case for themselves that people of J&K have joined India & Pakistan it is now their 'internal matter'. After the infamous assembly elections of 1987, wherein the pro-freedom voices of J&K ~~were~~ ^{were} part of a united front under the umbrella organisation named 'Muslim United Front' decided to contest elections to solve Kashmir Issue democratically & and to solve daily based issues of netizens. But ~~what~~ what happened in those elections remains a black chapter in the history of Kashmir. The Indian government claiming to be the world's largest democracy proved a shame in J&K. By the help of proxies they had created lead by Farooq Abdullah at that time (son of Sheikh Abdullah who sold Kashmir to attain power) Indian government rigged the elections & managed a win for their candidates against the mood of people, who had over joyously participated & voted for MUF in the elections. Many of leaders of MUF were arrested, humiliated & many were killed also. This became the turning point in the history of Kashmir.

The people of Kashmir who by now had used every peaceful method to seek resolution of Kashmir issue rose in rebellion and started an armed resistance against the illegal occupation ~~of India~~ their land. Mohammed Yousuf Shah, now a globally declared terrorist with now degenrs Syed Salahudin was one among the contestants of assembly elections, who was later arrested & jailed. Also joined the armed struggle which continues till date. Some of the members of MUF including Hussiyat Patriach Syed Ali Qadri - the face of Kashmir's resistance movement ~~continued~~ to managed to win elections from their constituencies & raised the K-issue in assembly, but they too realised after some time that they were using the wrong ^{platform} methods to seek ~~right~~ their legitimate right.

* Armed Resistance - a ~~to~~ new chapter ^{in Kashmir resistance.} when people of Kashmir failed to achieve their legitimate right through peaceful methods & joined armed struggle, Pakistan a party to K-dispute was morally bound to provide logistical & ~~moral~~ ^{moral} support to ~~the~~ ^{defected} ~~people~~ ^{people} of Kashmir, who had no means & logistics of their own to rise against a powerful colonial country like India.

And in this endeavour too, Pakistan proved itself to be the well wisher of Kashmiris by not only providing them with logistical support but also provided them every kind of assistance, ~~the~~ it providing land & weaponry in training camps or money and other kinds of diplomatic support.

But as is said, ~~the~~ Every movement faces tough times, so it also happened with armed resistance movement, which in its initial days was unorganised, unmotivational, lacking specific goals & without proper strategy. Thus ~~the~~ ^{its} fate was bound to create chaos. Most of the men who went to other side of Kashmir to get arms training were either lacking basic knowledge of conflict or were driven by charismatic or materialistic revolutionaries, who were more concerned to create an aura of heroism & bravado around them than to work and fight against the illegal occupation. And the result wasn't ~~same as~~ ^{different from} like what happened with other armed resistance around the world. The ~~p~~ men who had a strong inspiration driven from their religion, solid motivation of their ideology & irrevocable faith in their mission, only survived in the movement. Rest of the people either fall into the trap of Indian and foreign intelligence agencies or surrendered to ~~what~~ ^{start} what they call a 'peaceful' struggle.

In addition to these two groups, there was a third group of 'Armed fighters' who were created by Indian agencies as shadowy organisations to create ~~split~~ rift among Mujahideen & to work for Indian establishment. This group ~~was~~ was the responsible for most of civilian killings under the guise of Mujahideen and later went to form pro government Militia - Ikhwan. This Ikhwan, later on created the bloody history in the every nook & corner of Kashmir, with the support of Indian army & its agencies, this local group of armed men was given every kind of impunity & licence to kill, rape, abduct, loot & torture innocent civilians. Government of India used this group to break the resolve of freedom loving Kashmiris, more specifically to those who were directly or indirectly related with either Mujahideen or the Kashmir's largest socio-political organisation - Jamaat-e-Islami. From 1991 to around 2002, this group operated in every district with the supplies being provided to them by successive governments in J&K.

Then came 2002, which marked another significant chapter in history of Kashmir. The Indian politicians establishment which has massacred lacs of muslims of J&K till their period,

understood that despite killing civilians & armed resistance fighters, it was difficult to win the minds of people. Thus started another operation 'Soft Separatism'.

The ruthless National Conference (JNC) which was used to solidify occupation by using brutal methods was cornered and an IB created PDP came into existence headed by India's most trustworthy Man in Kashmir - Mufti ~~Bayed~~ (May his soul burn in Hell). He came with an idea of soft separation and befooled many 'freedom loving' people too. On the one hand, he talked of 'revocation of the inhumane laws like AFSPA & PSA & vacation of Army from civilian areas, Talks with Hussiyat Leaders & ^{executed} Pakistan, on the other hand his regime planned killings of big militant commanders. While the people were relieved to see an end of Ikhwan, but hardly they know that this group was not disarmed or dismantled, but was absorbed in civilian JK Police to be used later for the same purpose of its creation. Any how, post 2002 saw a 'relative' 'enforced peace' in Kashmir. People were promised ~~steel~~ stars on one side, but the plans of destruction were going on simultaneously. The intellectual class of our society also failed to ~~see~~ the actual designs of

this party & most of the writers, columnists, academicians, Journalists, civil society members were either made to fall in the trap or were offered the price for creating the narrative for this party & its policies. Ah!

2008 - reasons, & consequences.

The anger was ~~an~~ accumulating & the volcano had to burst anytime. The period of enforced peace and then the false promises by pro Indian political parties to resolve the K-issue politically has begun to puncture. The processes of 'peace talks' with some naive hurrayat leaders had proven yet another ploy of Indian agencies to buy time and strengthen its roots. In this process, many freedom loving activists, leaders & academicians were lured into pro Indian politics and Indian Army launched some so called 'people friendly' helpful schemes like "operation sadhbharva", only to divert the attention of masses from actual cause. Yes, it is true that the era of crackdowns, tortures, civilian killings & brutality got reduced to a certain level, but what was going behind the curtains was more dangerous than all this.

The pro Indian parties viz. Congress and newly formed JB creation PDP had much

a deal to transfer land ~~to~~ Amarnath Shrine Board, against the state subject laws. This was done to establish non-muslim colonies in the area to change demography of muslim majority region - a long ^{waited} pending plan of India. When people came to know about these plans, they rose in rebellion under the leadership of pro-freedom Leaders and Kashmir witnessed its first kind of ^{mass} 'Civilian uprising' ~~that~~ similarly like intifada movement of palestine. People from every nook and corner participated in these long civil marches called by Hurriyat Leader Syed Ali Geelani. It is estimated that only in the march called at 'TRC Ground', more than 10 Lakh people participated to protest against the 'Land transfer deal' and 'Illegal Indian occupation'. The civilian peaceful protests lasted for more than 4 months and the militant leadership acted wisely amidst all this period by not allowing its cadres to launch any attacks. But this peaceful uprising too was crushed by ^{enforcing} ~~used~~ Curfews & using brute force in which more than 50 youth lost their lives. Not before Indian govt revoked the decision of Land Transfer. Soon after crushing the peaceful Intifada, the Indian agencies played another wild

Cared, to hold assembly elections. People of Kashmir as usual were befooled ~~that~~ & made to believe that these elections have nothing to do with K-issue, ~~but~~ and are only meant to solve day to day issues like; water, electricity, roads etc. People participated in elections en masse and Indian agencies lured people by offering money to contest election to ensure maximum participation in polls. And yes, they succeeded in their mission despite Hussiyat patriach Syed Ali Geelani's continuous appeals that these elections are yet another drama & a ploy to strengthen occupation. But then, all this is the reality is occupation and conflict zones.

After the elections, people were again dismayed for what they noticed, that they were deceived by these pro-Indian politicians. Therefore, discontent was brewing and 2009 also witnessed continuous shutdowns & hartals. Then came 2010, another blood soaked year, in which around 150 innocent civilians were showered bullets for peacefully protesting against the cold blooded murder of 5 civilians in a fake encounter. People from every village & town participated in the civilian marches to protest against this inhumane act and illegal occupation.

Again Like previous years, after 2010 Indian agencies tried their everything to curb the pro-freedom struggle by arresting thousands of youths & putting them in Jails by slapping 'Public Safety Acts', putting Hussain & Islamist Leaders behind bars, using money to lure youth, propagating immorality etc.

Charismatic Militancy → A wave

When Indian establishment was busy in chalking out strategies to make their final blow on this pro-freedom movement, ~~the~~ some youths had made their way to forests to make their last attempts to contribute ^{their} blood.

The generation of 90's which hadn't seen the hey days of militancy were getting frustrated to ^{see} such a bloodshed on the streets. They had listened & read the stories of 90's, but had never imagined that India ~~could~~ claiming to be largest democracy in world couldn't even tolerate peaceful civilian protests on streets & would respond with bullets. They saw ~~at~~ all this happening with their naked eyes from 2008 to 2010. Thus the ~~frustration~~ ~~was~~ getting accumulated volcano had to burst anytime. It only needed a trigger.

After the failure of every civilian protest, youth who had decided to fight peacefully again felt the need of armed struggle. In 2010, these

were only few boys who were active on armed ~~stage~~ front. But after this there was an continued upsurge and boys from well off families with good academics had moved to fronts. This group was lead by a young boy ~~of~~ in his 20's, who revolutionised the armed movement by revealing his identity on social media - which on one side frustrated the Indian securities & on the other side provided a last hope to dismayed youth of Kashmir. He was 'Bushan' - the famous Bushan name.

Kashmir after Bushan
