

FROM THE TRANSLATOR

In translating the poetic vocabulary employed by Ismaaciil Mire I have approached to this rather difficult task from two complementary angles : firstly, I have given the ordinary meaning of the given term as it is used by the native Somali speakers, particularly by the pastoral community to whom the poet belonged; and secondly, in most cases I have given the meaning which a word assumed in an specific poetic context. I have ascertained this last point by referring to the particular verse in which the term appears in the collected poems from which the present translation is made, entitled : ISMAACIIL MIRE published by The Ministry of Culture and Higher Education (1974) edited by Axmed F. Cali "Idaajaa". The poet often gives an special meaning to an ordinary word in the language, or coins a new term, such a method being known as poetic license. For example, Mire used the word KAC in the following different constructions :

- 1 KAC - imperative form of the verb meaning to stand up, which is the ordinary meaning of the term;
- 2 KAC - transitive verb meaning to undertake a journey;
- 3 KAC - intransitive verb meaning to be ruined through the loss of one's property, especially livestock. The second and third meanings of the term are the non-literal usages of this term and poet Mire's language is replete with this kind of word-changing. Where a word-for-word translation is impossible I have rendered the Somali sense of a word into English by means of a general description of the meaning; for example, GEEL-XERAAD : camel herds that are taken away from the family home to distant pastures during the dry seasons when grazing resources are not available nearer home.

Due attention had also been given to the general definitions of the terms prepared by The Lexicographic Committee of The Somali Academy of Sciences and Arts. The terms collected by this group consist mainly of the two grammatical categories of nouns and verbs.

The gender of the nouns and the verbal patterns are indicated in the translation. The adjectives in Somali have verbal functions and they are classed as verbs in the terms included in this vocabulary. The remaining parts of speech are not yet defined due to the absence of an standard Somali Grammar. Hence, the other grammatical categories are not considered in the present material.

Similarly, the present translator had taken note of the methods followed by earlier translators of materials in Somali into foreign languages, such as Rev. Fr. Evangelist De Larjasse, Somali-English and English-Somali Dictionary 1897; Abraham R.C., Somali-English Dictionary, 1962; Dr. Yaasiin Cismaan Keenadiid who compiled the first Somali monolingual Dictionary, 1976.

Poet Ismaaciil Mire (1884-1950) was one of the outstanding pastoral Somali poets and his poetry concerns with the life of the Somali pastoralists. The present collection is but an small fraction of his vast poetic works which earned much fame for the poet in his life-time among the pastoral society, which by no means diminished to this day. The present translator, having born and bred among that pastoral community is well acquainted with the socio-cultural life of his own people.

Having graduated from The Moscow State University (1968) in Philology, the present translator is a member of the Somali National Language Commission from 1971 to date. He has participated in the compilation of the first Somali-Italian Dictionary published in 1984 by The Ministry of Culture and Higher Education. This project was initiated in 1978 by the late Prof. Francesco Agostini of The Comitato Tecnico Linguistico dell'U.N.S., who trained a number of Somali researchers in the modern techniques of lexicography. At the moment the translator is the Dean of The Institute of Arts of The Somali Academy of Sciences and Arts.

With this background and experience the translator made an attempt to translate into English the poetic vocabulary employed by poet Mire, totalling to about three thousand terms. Although it is difficult to translate poetry from one to another language, and also the fact that a certain aspect of the spirit of the original is often lost through translation, yet, I am confident that the present translation is as close to the spirit of the Somali original as can be.
