November, 2004	USS Nimitz "Tic-Tac" incident off coast of S. California. Pilot records "FLIR" video.	
2007	Advanced Aerospace Weapons Systems Application Program (AAWSAP) initiates to study UAP and associated phenomena. Operates for 2 years.	
2007	Defense Intelligence Agency scientist Dr. James Lacatski has "Tubular Bells" incident at Skinwalker Ranch	
2009	AAWSAP investigates TicTac case with extensive personal interviews with pilots and radar operators	
2009	AAWSAP identifies "hitchiker" phenomenon and proposes an "infectious agent" model of transmission	
2009	AAWSAP conducts "deep dives" on purported medical effects of UAP exposure. Concludes exposure is a potential threat to human health.	Media
2010	AAWSAP changes into AATIP (Advanced Aerospace Threat Identification Program), studies UAP, headed by L. Elizondo. Formal funding lasts until 2012.	Congress
late 2014	Off Virginia Beach, Navy pilot "almost hit" a UAP that looked like a "sphere encased in a cube", as reported by squadron mate Lt. Ryan Graves	Defense Department
January, 2015	USS Roosevelt experiences "daily" UAP incidents off coast of Jacksonville, FL. Pilots record "Gimbal" and "Go Fast" videos	Intelligence Agencies
October, 2017	Luis Elizondo resigns as Director of AATIP, cites internal opposition to further UAP research	Private
October, 2017	Delonge, Puthoff, Elizondo, Mellon, Semivan, et al. announce formation of To the Stars Academy of Arts and Science (TTSA)	Academia
December, 2017	In Washington Post article, pilot David Fravor recounts TicTac incident, stating "it was a real object" and speculating it was "something not from the Earth"	Other Exec. Branch
December, 2017	New York Times article "Glowing Auras and Black Money" reveals AATIP(AAWSAP), publishes TicTac military videos "Gimbal", "Go Fast", & "FLIR"	
March, 2019	US Navy creates standard reporting mechanism for UAP	
May, 2019	History Channel airs first of two consecutive seasons of "Unidentified", chronicling work of TTSA	
September, 2019	US Navy confirms authenticity of 2004 (Nimitz) and 2015 (Roosevelt) TicTac videos and describes subjects as "unidentified aerial phenomena"	
October, 2019	TTSA confirms CRADA agreement with US Army to study "exotic" material	
July, 2020	In NY Times article, physicist Eric Davis states he gave classified DoD briefing regarding "off-world vehicles not made on this earth."	
July, 2020	Senator Marco Rubio states that "If it's something from outside this planet, that might actually be better" than if UAP are from our adversaries	
November, 2020	US Air Force adopts standard reporting mechanism for UAP	
December, 2020	COVID relief bill signed into law, including language from Senate Intelligence Committee to have a UAP Task Force prepare report in 180 days	
December, 2020	Obama-era CIA Director John Brennan suggests that the origin of the UAP is something that "some might say constitutes a different form of life."	
December, 2020	Elizondo, Mellon, and Justice announce departure from TTSA, cite desire to focus less on entertainment and more on advancing UAP disclosure	
March, 2021	Former Director of National Intelligence John Ratcliffe acknowledges UAP conducting "movements we don't have the technology for".	
April, 2021	Pentagon confirms authenticity of "pyramid" UAP videos, and that they were being evaluated by the UAP Task Force	
May, 2021	60 Minutes airs serious segment on UAP. Mainstream media coverage ensues	
May, 2021	Former President Barak Obama acknowledges UAP and states "We can't explain how they moved, their trajectory".	
May, 2021	Following complaint by Elizondo, DoD Inspector General launches evaluation of "the extent to which DoD has taken actions regarding UAP"	
June, 2021	UAP Task Force releases report stating 143/144 incidents investigated "remain unexplained", recommends formal ongoing study	
June, 2021	Luis Elizondo states public response would be "somber" if they knew what he knows regarding UAP	
June, 2021	Sen. Mitt Romney states "I don't believe they are coming from foreign adversaries...Russia and China aren't there, and neither are we, by the way."	
July, 2021	Harvard astronomer Avi Loeb announces formation of Galileo Project to study UAP with independent, transparent data collection	
October, 2021	NASA Administrator Bill Nelson expresses strong interest in UAP, brings up topic in concert with discussion of search for alien life	
October, 2021	<i>Skinwalkers at the Pentagon</i> is published by Lacatski, Kelleher, and Knapp, detailing AAWSAP program. Program manager J. Lacatski breaks silence.	
October, 2021	Luis Elizondo states "occupancy" is visible in some classified UAP photographs	
November, 2021	In a public forum, DNI Aviril Haines states that UAP may be things that we "simply do not understand, which might come extraterrestrially"	
December, 2021	2021 NDAA signed into law, including "Gillibrand Amendment" that directs DoD and IC to fund/implement major effort to study UAP, share data, and report to congress
