3. These things are good and true, but God doesn't stop there. What does Deuteronomy 10:12-13 say that we must give to the Lord?
4. In Psalm 78:8 we find a negative example. David tells us how *not* to live. What do these people withhold from God, and how is their character described?
5. God has an understandable desire for us to give Him our all. The Scriptures urge us to do things wholeheartedly!
