

For instance, Dale Carnegie, author of the international best-selling books How to Win Friends and Influence People and How to Stop Worrying and Start Living, referred to Adler as "a great psychologist who devoted his life to researching humans and their latentabilities." Carnegie's books How to Win Friends and Influence People and How to Stop Worrying and Start Living have sold millions of copies around the world. There is no question that Adler's way of thinking had a significant impact on all of his writings.

And a significant portion of the information presented in Stephen Covey's book, The 7 Habits of Highly Effective People, is strikingly similar to that presented by Adler. In other words, Adlerian psychology is generally accepted as a realization, a culmination of truths and of human understanding rather than as a specific field of academic study. On the other hand, it is said that Adler's ideas were one hundred years ahead of their time, and even now, we have not been able to fully comprehend them.
