A. L. Totten (1851–1908) and Russel Kelso Carter (1849– 1928). Daniel Parker (1781–1844) was also responsible for reviving and promoting the doctrine among Primitive Baptists.

In 1910, Benjamin Purnell from the House of David in Benton, Michigan published a book entitled, "The Star of Bethlehem" which contained details of the Serpent's Seed

It was preached by Branham in 1958.
