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HOW TO SPOT A DROWNING CHILD


DON'T WAIT
for these "Hollywood" drowning signals:

- shouting for help
- splashing
- waving arms
- kicking








ACT IMMEDIATELY
if you notice these signs of drowning:

- head tilted back with mouth at water level
- gasping or hyperventilating
- glassy, unfocused eyes
- hair is covering forehead/eyes (not brushing it out of the way)
- body is vertical and legs are motionless



WHAT YOU CAN DO TO PREVENT TRAGEDY

 Always designate a caregiver who hasn't been drinking alcohol to be responsible for maintaining visual contact of your child	 Check that your child's life vest is US Coast Guard approved and designed for his/her age and the type of environment you're in.
 Install a climb-resistant fence made from a material like mesh with a self-locking gate to keep children out of the pool when unsupervised	
 If a child is missing, always check the water first.	 Learn CPR and lifeguarding skills and ask family and friends to do the same.
