Waco Fire Chief Announces Retirement After 41 Years in the Fire Service

After three and one-half years with this organization and forty-one years in the Fire Service, this decision has been reached with a heart full of gratitude for this incredible journey.

By taking proactive measures, we are safeguarding the health and well-being of our firefighters, ensuring they have the support and resources they need to lead healthy lives.

Providing a second set of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for each firefighter is a testament to our unwavering commitment to their safety. This initiative ensures their well-being and sets a new standard for the industry, showcasing my dedication to the men and women who serve our community.

The organization has grown stronger with the addition of 19 firefighter positions, bolstering our operational capabilities and providing opportunities for new talent to join our ranks. This expansion has infused our department with fresh perspectives and skills, enriching the department's collective expertise.

Technological advancements have revolutionized Waco Fire's operations. Implementing the Digital Asset Tracking System, Document Management System, and the purchase of the IP-Based Fire Station Alerting System have enhanced our data capabilities, providing us with the tools and insights necessary to respond swiftly and effectively to emergencies.

As I prepare to embark on a new chapter in life, I will leave with a sense of fulfillment and immense pride in all that has been accomplished during my tenure. The City Manager Office (CMO) has played an integral role in shaping our department into what it is today, and for that, I'll be forever grateful.
