Trip hazard on loose wires and cables from camera equipment	Cast and Crew	M	Ensure that the cables are held down with tape to prevent the trip hazard and make sure cast and crew are aware of where these cables are.
Risk of Electric Shock when plugging/unplugging the plugs and cables	Cast and Crew	M	Make sure that the plugs and wires are all in working order with no breaks, and to avoid touching the metal parts of the plug
Risk of getting attacked by cat	Cast and Crew	H	Put the pet in another room to avoid them interfering with the recording
Lighting equipment can get hot after prolonged use and possibly cause a fire	Cast and Crew	H	Turn off the lighting equipment when not in use and never leave them unattended
