

FISABALL 2017 – Rules and Regulations

FISABALL - *Inter-collegiate sports tournament, featuring Football, Basketball, chess, running, video games, volleyball and tennis.*

Dates: Saturday 1st April and Sunday 2nd April 2017.

Venue: M.S. Palya Road, Vaishnavi Layout, Bengaluru, Karnataka 560097

Time: 8:30am-5pm

Reporting time: 8:00 am

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS.

1. Each team should register on or before 26th of March, with duly filled application form along with the copies of **each player's college identity card.**
2. Registration fees : **Football : Rs.2,000 , Basketball : Rs.2,000 , Tennis : Rs.200 , Video games :Rs.200, Volleyball :Rs.1500, Running :Rs. 300 and chess: Rs.300** (per team).
3. Each team should consist of International students.
4. Each college can participate in all three games or two games or one game, based on their choice and availability of players.
5. There can be no more than one team from a single college, to a one particular game.
6. Referees and the organizing committee have authority to disqualify a team in case of misbehavior or at a situation of failing to obey the rules of the game.
7. Teams should play in accordance with the rules and regulations listed below.
8. One player –one games.

Rules and Regulations - Football:

Number of players: **Seven (7)** players (on the ground at one time) plus **Three (3)**

Substitutes per team are allowed - A team of no more than **ten (10)**
Players.

Duration of a Match: The game is played in 2 halves consisting of **15 minutes** each. The half time interval may not exceed more than 5 minutes. If the score are tied at the end of the second half, the game will go into a 5 minute overtime period or shall be played according to the decision taken by the referee. *(Subject to change)*

International laws of the game shall be applied and the referee/referees shall ensure the Laws of the Game are respected and upheld.

Rules and Regulations - Basketball:

Number of players: **Five (5)** players (on the court at one time) plus **five (5)** substitutes is allowed – A team of no more than **ten (10)** players.

The duration of a Match: **40 minutes** only. The game is divided into **4** quarters, each 10 minutes long. If the score are tied at the end of the fourth quarter, the game will go into a 5 minute overtime period. If the game ties at the end of overtime, game shall be played According to the decision taken by the referee. (*Subject to change*)

International laws of the game shall be applied and the referee/referees shall ensure the Laws of the Game are respected and upheld.

Rules and regulations – Table tennis.

Number of players: Single (1 player) or Double (2 players).

Duration of a Match:

___-Match will be played best 3 of 5 games.

-For each game, the first player (team) to reach 11 points wins that game, however a game must be won by at least a two point's margin.

-Touching the table with a bat or body gives a point to one's opponent.

-Players must use 2 consecutive services on their turn. If match type is double, only one particular player performs 2 services on the turn of his/her team until next turn.

-Any unethical action which is performed by a player against referees, opponents or spectators could be a reason to be disqualified.

-International laws of the game shall be applied and the referee/referees shall ensure the Laws of the Game are respected and upheld.

Volleyball Rules

FISA-B will be using the international rules during the Volleyball games.

Teams should:

- Team has 6 players on the court.
- 3 players are front row players and 3 of them are back row players.
- Team is allowed to use a libero player (back row player, defensive specialist) who wears different color shirt.
- The team are required to come with a uniform.

Awards and Prizes

Winners of each sport will be awarded with a trophy, gold medals and certificates for each team member.

First runners-up will be awarded with a trophy, silver medals and certificates for each player in the team.

All the participants will be given a participation certificate.

Winners and first runners-up of this tour will be awarded with cash prizes.
