Kentucky Christian Conference CYA Rules for Youth Camp

Conduct

- 1. We must keep an attitude of Christian love for one another.
- 2. Express love by being obedient. You must follow the workers' directions at all times.
- 3. Everyone must participate in all scheduled activities and services.
- 4. The following are NOT allowed: fireworks, glass bottles, weapons, guns, knives, or anything that looks like them. No alcohol, tobacco, and drug use or paraphernalia to drug use. No water, toothpaste, or shaving cream fights.
- 5. Profanity or obscene language will not be accepted.
- 6. No loud music played after lights out. Only Christian/Gospel music is to be played.

Dress Code

- 1. Everyone must dress modestly at all times.
- 2. BOYS: No shorts, tank tops, or sweatpants.
- 3. GIRLS: No shorts, skorts, pants, split skirts, or sleeveless outfits. All skirts and dresses must be right above the knee or longer.

Cleanliness and Hygiene

- 1. Everyone must shower daily.
- 2. Rooms are to be cleaned daily and will be inspected.
- 3. All debris, soft drink cans/bottles must be put into garbage cans.
- 4. Everyone is responsible for picking up garbage on the grounds throughout the day.

General Rules & Camp Safety

- 1. Campers are to be under the age of 18.
- 2. If you are 18 years of age or older, you must have a signed paper from your pastor stating that you may help out at youth camp.
- 3. You must have permission by a camp officer before leaving the grounds.
- 4. All campers must stay until pickup on Friday unless prior arrangements have been made. When leaving, parents must sign their child out.
- 5. All automobiles kept on the grounds by youth campers must be parked near the cafeteria and notice given to workers when leaving, with names of any passengers.
- 6. Everyone must stay in their assigned room. No switching unless approved by a camp officer.
- 7. You must stay in your assigned room after lights out.
- 8. Even if you are 18 years or older you must abide by camp rules.
- 9. Certain areas are off limits:
- The cafeteria except at meal times.
- Girls and boys are not allowed in or near each other's rooms.

- Inside the concession stand.
- The showers except at assigned shower times.
- Camping area- unless you have a camper there.
- 10. Medicine for all campers will be kept by an adult, appointed by the youth board. Prescription drugs must be in the correct container or they will be viewed as an illegal drug. Anyone caught with illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia will be asked to leave. We reserve the right to drug test any camper at any necessary time.
- 11. No public displays of affection for campers. Includes no hand holding or kissing at any time.
- 12. Cell phones must be used for emergency used only. Anyone with a cell phone must be identified and have a parent sign saying they are responsible for its use.
- 13. Anyone who does not obey these rules or anyone who poses a hazard to others may be asked to leave.
