What Is a Certified Trust and Fiduciary Advisor (CTFA)?

The Certified Trust and Fiduciary Advisor (CTFA) is a professional designation offered by the American Bankers Association (ABA), [Certified Trust and Financial Advisor](#) which provides training and knowledge in levies, investments, fiscal planning, trusts, and estates. preliminarily called the Certified Trust and Financial Advisor instrument, the ABA replaced "Financial" in the title with the word "Fiduciary".

The CTFA credential is applicable for professionals who have a career in banking, brokering, fiscal planning, taxation, or trust administration.

Understanding a Certified Trust and Fiduciary Advisor (CTFA)

The CTFA instrument demonstrates moxie in the trust and fiscal advising profession. To admit the designation, campaigners must have a minimal position of wealth operation work experience, complete approved training programs, and pass an examination. Continuing education (CE) is also demanded to maintain the CTFA designation.
