

Elon Musk Visits Pope Francis with his Children during a Trip to Italy

Elon Musk broke his nine-day silence on Twitter to share a surprise visit to meet Pope Francis with four of his seven children. He even joked about his ill-fitting suit.

Musk tweeted on Friday night, "Honored to meet @Pontifex Yesterday." Musk took four of his five teenagers to the Vatican in Rome.

His fifth teen, who was previously known as Xavier was announced last month she's now a transgender person known as Vivian Jenna Wilson, and she has decided not to be associated with her billionaire dad.

Musk admitted that the black tailored outfit he was wearing was not befitting of the occasion, and he responded to a Twitter user who mocked his outfit by replying "My suit is tragic.."

Musk has spoke of being an atheist, so it is not clear what motivated him to meet the pope, and what the two men discussed.

Vivian was joined by Griffin, Vivian's twin brother and his 16-year-old triplets, Kai, Damian, and Saxon, for the trip.

Musk was married to Justine Wilson, a Canadian author, from 2000 until 2008.

Their first son, Nevada, was born in 2002, and passed away of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS) at the age of 10 weeks. Musk and Wilson had five more children. Twin sons Xavier, Griffin, and triplet boys Damian, Kai, and Saxon were born.

Their five children have mostly kept them away from the spotlight. In 2010 twins Griffin and Xavier, who are now Vivian were spotted with Elon his second wife, Talulah.

The mogul has five teenage children, all from his marriage to Justine Wilson, author. He divorced her in 2008. He is pictured with his triplets who were born in 2006.

Despite their father sharing joint custody, the five teenagers kept a low profile.

Musk also two other children, X AE A-Xii and Exa Dark Siderael, who goes by Y with Canadian singer Grimes.

Musk was not raised a Catholic.

The 50-year-old South African billionaire was baptized when he was young and was a student at Anglican Sunday School, but he has said he doesn't consider himself a Christian.

Musk declared to Babylon Bee in January that Musk was in agreement with the principles Jesus was a proponent of. There is a lot of wisdom in the doctrines of Jesus, and I agree with his teachings.'

He said, "Things such as "turn the other cheek" are more important than "an eye for an eye". Everyone is blind when an eye for an eye is used.

"Forgiveness is essential, as is treating people as you'd like to be treated. "Love your neighbor as you would want to be treated.'

"But, Hey, If Jesus is saving people, then I won't hinder His work.

'Sure, I'll be saved. Why would I not?

The tweets posted on Friday brought back the platform by Musk after a nine-day hiatus.

He returned with a tribute to the YouTube gamer, who died of cancer.

With a photo of Sonic the Hedgehog, the image was captioned with "Popular Minecraft YouTuber Technoblade with 12 billion subscribers has passed away at 23 from cancer, and this made [me] realize that cancer is an absurd piece of death and garbage. However, you must also strive to live your life with people who know. You would regret not having done things with them the next day."

He also posted a photo of him celebrating his 40th birthday in Venice with his then-wife, British actress Talulah Riley.

'Venice, a site of Great Remembrance.'

He said, "Feeling... maybe... a little bored?"
