



## NOTICE



Greetings member of An Garda Síochána, I accept and acknowledge your oath of office which is:

“I hereby solemnly and sincerely declare before God that I will faithfully discharge the duties of a member of An Garda Síochána with fairness, integrity, regard for human rights, diligence and impartiality, upholding the constitution and the law and according equal respect to all people, while I continue to be a member, I will to the best of my skill and knowledge discharge all my duties according to law, and I do not belong to, and will not while I remain a member form, belong to or subscribe to, any political party or secret society whatsoever.”.

You are hereby on **NOTICE** that pursuant to the Preamble and Article 41;1.1 of Bunreacht Na Heireann which states; "The State recognises the Family as the natural primary and fundamental unit group of Society, and as a moral institution possessing inalienable and imprescriptible rights, antecedent and superior to **all positive law**".

My family has rights, which are superior to all positive law, which you may wish to enforce, however, you swore to uphold those family rights. My journey today is lawful and it is my inalienable, imprescriptible right to make this journey unhindered.

Further take NOTICE that my family right, to earn a livelihood, is also an inalienable, imprescriptible right and is therefore superior to any positive law you may wish to enforce today.

You are hereby put on NOTICE that should you breach your oath of office by infringing any of my family's inalienable and imprescriptible rights and not uphold same as you swore to do, then I reserve my right to sue you in your private capacity, I trust this will not be necessary and I expect you to allow me to continue my journey and to earn a livelihood without any further interference. For the avoidance of any doubt, I will not be discussing any private family matters outside of the family.
