MYSTERY KAL – BABY BLANKET

SIZE: approx. 80cm x 80cm

MATERIAL:

approx. 800m of any yarn suitable for needle size 4-5mm, i.e.Drops Puna, Karisma or Lima

- 5mm knitting needles
- tapestry needle

KNITTING GAUGE:

18 stitches x 25 rows (approx. 10cm x 10cm) in stockinette stitch

PATTERNS:

<u>Stockinette stitch</u> (right side): knit all stitches / (wrong side): purl all stitches <u>Garter stitch</u> (right side): knit all stitches / (wrong side): knit all stitches = 1 'ridge' on right side

k = knit

p = purl

INSTRUCTIONS - BABY BLANKET:

80cm wide: Cast on 141 stitches (100cm: 181 stitches & 120cm: 221 stitches). Continue in garter stitch until piece measures approx. 5cm (in my case that's 8 ridges on right side).

Continue as follows:

The first and last 10 stitches of the blanket will always be knitted in garter stitch = border of the blanket. The patterns are only knitted over the middle 121 (or 161 / 201) stitches.

GOOD TO KNOW: After every pattern I knitted a few rows of garter stitch so that the patterns are separated but also so I would <u>always start a new pattern on the right side</u>.

If you would like to make a bigger (longer) blanket there are a few patterns that can be knitted longer (or that can be repeated again later). There is a total amount of 8 patterns that are easily adjusted in height.

PART 1 (pattern repeat over 10 stitches):



Row 1: Knit 3 stitches, purl 5 sts, *k5, p5* - repeat *-* until 3 sts are left (of the middle 121/161/201) Knit the last 3 sts and turn your work.

Row 2-5: Knit above knit, purl above purl

Repeat these 5 rows another 2 times until a total of 15 rows have been knitted.

This pattern can be adjusted in height.

Continue in garter stitch until 3 ridges appear on right side and you can start the next pattern on right side. Should you have 2 or 4 ridges that is also fine ©

PART 2 (pattern repeat over 2 stitches):



Row 1: Knit all stitches

Row 2: Purl 1, *k1, p1* - repeat *-* until the end of row

Repeat row 1&2 another 4 times (= 10 rows in total)

This pattern can be adjusted in height.

Continue in garter stitch until 1 ridge appears on right side and you can start the next pattern on right side.

PART 3 (pattern repeat over 4 stitches):



Row 1: Purl 1, *k3, p1* - repeat *-* until the end of the row.

Row 2: Purl all stitches.

Row 3: K2, p1, *k3, p1* - repeat *-* until 2 sts are left. Knit last 2 stitches.

Row 4: Purl all stitches.

Repeat these 4 rows another 3 times (= 16 rows in total).

This pattern can be adjusted in height.

Continue in garter stitch until 2 ridges appear on right side and you can start the next pattern on right side.

PART 4 (pattern repeat over 7 stitches):



For all blankets:

Row 1-4: Knit in stockinette.

For blankets with 121 stitches in the middle:

Row 5: K4, *p1, k6* - repeat *-* until 5 sts are left. P1, k4.

Row 6: P3, *k3, p4* - repeat *-* until 6 sts are left. K3, p3.

Row 7: K2, *p5, k2* - repeat *-* until the end of the row.

Row 8: P2, *k5, p2* - repeat *-* until the end of the row.

Row 9: K2, *p2, k1, p2, k2* - - repeat *-* until the end of the row.

For blankets with 161 stitches in the middle:

Row 5: K3, *p1, k6* - repeat *-* until 4 sts are left. P1, k3.

Row 6: P2, *k3, p4* - repeat *-* until 5 sts are left. K3, p2.

Row 7: K1, *p5, k2* - repeat *-* until 6 sts are left. P5, k1.

Row 8: P1, *k5, p2* - repeat *-* until 6 sts are left. K5, p1.

Row 9: K1, *p2, k1, p2, k2* - repeat *-* until 6 sts are left. P2, k1, p2, k1.

For blankets with 201 stitches in the middle:

Row 5: K6, *p1, k6* - repeat *-* until 6 sts are left. P1,k5.

Row 6: P4, *k3, p4* - repeat *-* until 8 sts are left. K3, p5.

Row 7: K4, *p5, k2* - repeat *-* until 1 sts is left. K1.

Row 8: P3, *k5, p2* - repeat *-* until 2 sts are left. P2.

Row 9: K4, *p2, k1, p2, k2* - repeat *-* until 1 sts is left. K1.

For all blankets:

Row 10-13: Knit in stockinette.

Continue in garter stitch until 2 ridges appear on right side and you can start the next pattern on right side.

PART 5 (pattern repeat over 11 stitches):



For blankets with 121 stitches in the middle:

Row 1+11: *p1, k9, p1* - repeat *-* until the end of the row.

Row 2+10: *p1, k1, p7, k1, p1* - repeat *-* until the end of the row.

Row 3+9: *k2, p1, k5, p1, k2* - repeat *-* until the end of the row.

Row 4+8: *p3, k1, p3, k1, p3* - repeat *-* until the end of the row.

Row 5+7: *k4, p1, k1, p1, k4* - repeat *-* until the end of the row.

Row 6: *p5, k1, p5* - repeat *-* until the end of the row.

For blankets with 161 stitches in the middle:

Row 1+11: k3, p1, *p1, k9, p1* - repeat *-* until 3 sts are left. P1, k2.

Row 2+10: p1, k1, p1, *p1, k1, p7, k1, p1* - repeat *-* until 4 sts are left. P1, k1, p2.

Row 3+9: k1, p1, k2, *k2, p1, k5, p1, k2* - repeat *-* until 3 sts are left. K2, p1.

Row 4+8: P3, *p3, k1, p3, k1, p3* - repeat *-* until 4 sts are left. P3, K1.

Row 5+7: K4, *k4, p1, k1, p1, k4* - repeat *-* until 3 sts are left. K3.

Row 6: P3, *p5, k1, p5* - repeat *-* until 4 sts are left. P4.

For blankets with 201 stitches in the middle:

Row 1+11: K1, p1, *p1, k9, p1* - repeat *-* until 1 sts is left. P1.

Row 2+10: P1, *p1, k1, p7, k1, p1* - repeat *-* until 2 sts are left. P1, K1.

Row 3+9: K2, *k2, p1, k5, p1, k2* - repeat *-* until 1 sts is left. K1.

Row 4+8: P1, *p3, k1, p3, k1, p3* - repeat *-* until 2 sts are left. P2.

Row 5+7: K2, *k4, p1, k1, p1, k4* - repeat *-* until 1 sts is left. K1.

Row 6: P1, *p5, k1, p5* - repeat *-* until 2 sts are left. P2.

Continue in garter stitch until 1 ridge appears on right side and you can start the next pattern on right side.

PART 6 (pattern repeat over 2 stitches):



Row 1: P1, *k1, p1*- repeat *-* until the end of row

Row 2: Knit above knit, purl above purl

Row 3: K1, *P1, K1*- repeat *-* until the end of row *

Row 4: Knit above knit, purl above purl

Repeat row 1-4 another 4 times (= 20 rows in total) # This pattern can be adjusted in height.

Continue in garter stitch until 3 ridges appear on right side and you can start the next pattern on right side.

PART 7 (pattern repeat over 11 stitches):



For blankets with 121 stitches in the middle:

Row 1: Knit all stitches.

Row 2+11: *k1, p10*- repeat *-* until the end of row *

Row 3+10: *k9, p2* - repeat *-* until the end of row *

Row 4+9: *k3, p8* - repeat *-* until the end of row *

Row 5+8: *k7, p4* - repeat *-* until the end of row *

Row 6+7: *k5,p6* - repeat *-* until the end of row *

Row 12: Knit all stitches

For blankets with 161 stitches in the middle:

Knit the first <u>4 stitches & the last 3 stitches</u> also in garter stitch. Follow above pattern over the 154 stitches in the middle (= 14 times).

For blankets with 201 stitches in the middle:

Knit the first <u>2 stitches & the last stitch</u> also in garter stitch. Follow above pattern over the 198 stitches in the middle (= 18 times).

Continue in garter stitch until 1 ridge appears on right side and you can start the next pattern on right side.

PART 8 (pattern repeat over 9 stitches):



For all blankets:

Row 1: Purl all stitches.

Row 2: Knit all stitches.

For blankets with 121 stitches in the middle:

Row 3+11: P3, *p2, k3, p4* - repeat *-* until 1 sts is left. P1.

Row 4+10: K1, *k3, p5, k1* - repeat *-* until 3 sts are left. K3.

Row 5+7+9: P3, *k7, p2* - repeat *-* until 1 sts is left. P1.

Row 6+8: K1, *k2, p7* - repeat *-* until 3 sts are left. K3.

For blankets with 161 stitches in the middle:

Row 3+11: P5, *p2, k3, p4* - repeat *-* until 3 sts are left. P3.

Row 4+10: K3, *k3, p5, k1* - repeat *-* until 5 sts are left. K5.

Row 5+7+9: P5, *k7, p2* - repeat *-* until 3 sts are left. P3.

Row 6+8: K3, * k2, p7* - repeat *-* until 5 sts are left. K5.

For blankets with 201 stitches in the middle:

Row 3+11: P2, *p2, k3, p4* - repeat *-* until 1 sts is left. P1.

Row 4+10: K1, *k3, p5, k1* - repeat *-* until 2 sts are left. K2.

Row 5+7+9: P2, *k7, p2* - repeat *-* until 1 sts is left. P1.

Row 6+8: K1, * k2, p7* - repeat *-* until 2 sts are left. K2.

For all blankets:

Row 12: Knit all stitches.

Row 13: Purl all stitches.

Row 14: Knit all stitches.

PART 9 (pattern repeat over 6 stitches):



For all blankets:

Row 1: Knit all stitches.

Row 2: Purl all stitches.

For blankets with 121 stitches in the middle:

Row 3+5: K1, *p4, k2* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 4+6: *p2, k4* - repeat *-* until 1 sts is left. P1.

For blankets with 161 stitches in the middle:

Row 3+5: P3, k2, *p4, k2* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 4+6: *p2, k4* - repeat *-* until 5 sts are left. P2, k3.

For blankets with 201 stitches in the middle:

Row 3+5: P1, k2, *p4, k2* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 4+6: *p2, k4* - repeat *-* until 3 sts are left. P2, k1.

For all blankets:

Row 7: Knit all stitches.

Row 8: Purl all stitches.

For blankets with 121 stitches in the middle:

Row 9+11: P1 *p1, k2, p3* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 10+12: *K3, p2, k1* - repeat *-* until 1 sts is left. K1.

For blankets with 161 stitches in the middle:

Row 9+11: K2, p3, *p1, k2, p3* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 10+12: *k3, p2, k1* - repeat *-* until 5 sts are left. K3,p2.

For blankets with 201 stitches in the middle:

Row 9+11: P3 *p1, k2, p3* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 10+12: *k3, p2, k1* - repeat *-* until 3 sts are left. K3.

For all blankets:

Row 13: Knit all stitches.


Row 14: Purl all stitches.

Row 15-20: Knit rows 3-8 one more time.

This pattern can be adjusted in height.

Continue in garter stitch until 2 ridges appear on right side and you can start the next pattern on right side.

PART 10 (pattern repeat over 4 stitches):



Row 1: K1, * p1, k1* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 2: P1, * k1, p1* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 3: P1, * k3, p1* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 4: K1, * p3, k1* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 5: K1, * p1, k1* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 6: P1, * k1, p1* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 7: K2, * p1, k3* - repeat *-* until 3 sts are left. P1, k2.

Row 8: P2, * k1, p3* - repeat *-* until 3 sts are left. K1, p2.

Repeat row 1-8 another 2 times (= 24 rows in total)

This pattern can be adjusted in height.

Continue in garter stitch until 3 ridges appear on right side and you can start the next pattern on right side.

PART 11 (pattern repeat over 7 stitches):



For all blankets:

Row 1-4: Knit in stockinette.

For blankets with 121 stitches in the middle:

Knit the <u>first & last stitch</u> also in stockinette stitch. Follow below pattern over the 119 stitches in the middle (= 17 times).

For blankets with 161 stitches in the middle:

Follow below pattern over all 161 stitches in the middle (= 23 times).

For blankets with 201 stitches in the middle:

Knit the first <u>3 stitches & the last 2 stitches</u> also in stockinette stitch. Follow below pattern over the 196 stitches in the middle (= 28 times).

Row 5: *k3, p1, k3* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 6: *p2, k1, p1, k1, p2* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 7: *k1, p1, k3, p1, k1* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 8: *k1, p5, k1* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 9: *p1, k5, p1* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 10: *k1, p5, k1* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 11: *p1, k2, p1, k2, p1* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 12: *p1, k2, p1, k2, p1* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

For all blankets:

Row 13-16: Knit in stockinette.

Continue in garter stitch until 1 ridge appears on right side and you can start the next pattern on right side.

PART 12 (pattern repeat over 6 stitches):



For blankets with 121 stitches in the middle:

Row 1+3: *P2, k4* - repeat *-* until 1 sts is left. P1.

Row 2+4: K1, *P4, k2* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 5+7: *K2, p2, k2* - repeat *-* until 1 sts is left. K1.

Row 6+8: P1, *p2, k2, P2* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 9+11: *K4, p2* - repeat *-* until 1 sts is left. K1.

Row 10+12: P1, *K2, p4* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

For blankets with 161 stitches in the middle:

Row 1+3: *P2, k4* - repeat *-* until 5 sts are left. P2, k3.

Row 2+4: P3, k2, *P4, k2* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 5+7: *K2, p2, k2* - repeat *-* until 5 sts are left. K2, p2, k1.

Row 6+8: P1, k2, p2, *p2, k2, P2* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 9+11: *K4, p2* - repeat *-* until 5 sts are left. K4, p1.

Row 10+12: K1, p4, *K2, p4* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

For blankets with 201 stitches in the middle:

Row 1+3: *P2, k4* - repeat *-* until 3 sts are left. P2, k1.

Row 2+4: P1, k2, *P4, k2* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 5+7: *K2, p2, k2* - repeat *-* until 3 sts are left. K2, p1.

Row 6+8: K1, p2, *p2, k2, P2* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Row 9+11: *K4, p2* - repeat *-* until 3 sts are left. K3.

Row 10+12: P3, *K2, p4* - repeat *-* until the end of row.

Repeat row 1-12 another time (= 24 rows in total)

This pattern can be adjusted in height.

Continue in garter stitch until 1 ridge appears on right side and you can start the next pattern on right side.

PART 13 (pattern repeat over 8 stitches):



Row 1: *p1, k3, p1, k3* - repeat *-* until 1 sts is left. P1.

Row 2: P1, *k1, p5, k1, p1* - repeat *-* until the end of the row.

Row 3: *k2, p1, k3, p1, k1* - repeat *-* until 1 sts is left. K1.

Row 4: P1, *p2, k1, p1, k1, p3* - repeat *-* until the end of the row.

Repeat row 1-4 another 2 times and then knit another row 1 (= 13 rows in total). # This pattern can be adjusted in height.

BORDER:

Continue in garter stitch until you have as many ridges as you had at the beginning (in my case that's 8 ridges on right side). Cast off all stitches and weave in ends. You may want to block your blanket so that all patterns stretch to the same width.
