Microsoft blocks the "Join multi-player games" permissions by default when creating a Microsoft child account.

- Browse to Family Safety portal <https://account.microsoft.com/family> and login with a family organisers (parents) account.- Towards the bottom click "Manage my family's Xbox online settings"

- To the left, select "Privacy&online safety" - Select the account that is unable to play online games - Select "Xbox One/Windows 10 Internet Safety"

- At the bottom of the list of permissions set "Join multiplayer games" to Allow and click Submit

Close and reopen Minecraft.
