GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR APA

- 1 inch margins
- Double space (no extra space between paragraphs)
- Font 12 point, times new roman
- Title page
- Reference page

Title Page Running head: ABBREVIATED TITLE IN ALL CAPS 3 MAXIMUM OF **50 CHARACTERS** MAXIMUM of 12 words ► Full Title of Your Paper Your Name Portmore Community College

Note

The words "Running head" is on Title page ONLY.

All other pages' headers consist of page numbers and ABBREVIATED TITLE

In-Text Citations

1 author	(Author surname, publication year)
	Example: (Decenzo, 2008)
2 authors	(Author1 & Author2, publication year)
	Example 1: (Robbins & DeCenzo, 2008)
	Note: (used at the end of signal phrase) e.g. Management is the process of getting things done effectively and efficiently (Robbins & DeCenzo, 2008).
	Example 2: Robbins and DeCenzo (2008)
	Note: (used when author(s)' name(s) used as part of signal phrase) e.g. Robbins and DeCenzo (2008) defines management as the process of getting things done effectively and efficiently.
3-5 authors	First use (authors separated by commas, year)
	Subsequent use (first author et al., year)
	Example:
	i. (DeCenzo, Robbins, Brown, James & Simpson, 2008).
	ii. (DeCenzo et al., 2008)

6 or more authors	First use (Author1 et al., year)
autions	Example: (DeCenzo et al., 2008)
Authors	Include authors' initials in citation
with same surname	Example:
	S. Anderson (2016) and W. Anderson (2009)
Corporate author	If there is no individual author, use the organization as the author.
	(Name of Organization, year)
	Example: (Portmore Community College, 2015)
Two or more works within the	List two or more works by different authors within the same parenthesis alphabetically (the same order in which they appear in the reference list)
same parenthesis	Use a semi-colon to separate each citation
	Example:
	(Jones, 2001; Simpson, 2013)

Website	Use same author-date format (Author, year)
	Use date given on web page
	- Last updated
	- Last revised Found at bottom of webpage
	- Copyright date
	Note: Use organization as author if there is no individual author for the webpage.

Newspaper article	Author surname, First. Initial(s). (year, Month day). Title of article. <i>Title of Newspaper</i> , page number(s).
	Example:
	Sharma, A. (2015, November 22). Uprising of a nation in
	formation. The Sunday Gleaner, pp. E1, E2.
	Note: precede page numbers with p. (single page) or pp. (more than one page).
Magazine and	SAME FORMAT AS NEWSPAPER
journal articles	Exceptions - Magazines
ut trefes	• (year, Month dy)
	Exceptions – Journals
	• (year, Month day)
	Note: Insert "vol.#(issue#.)." between title of magazine/journal and page numbers

Webpage	Author surname, First. Initial(s). (year). <i>Title of article</i> .
	Retrieved from <u>http://www</u> .
	Example:
	Simpson, C. & Daley, E. (2012). How to write "A" papers.
	Retrieved from <u>http://www.pcc.edu.jm/communication/</u>
	Note: use name of organization as author if no individual author is listed
