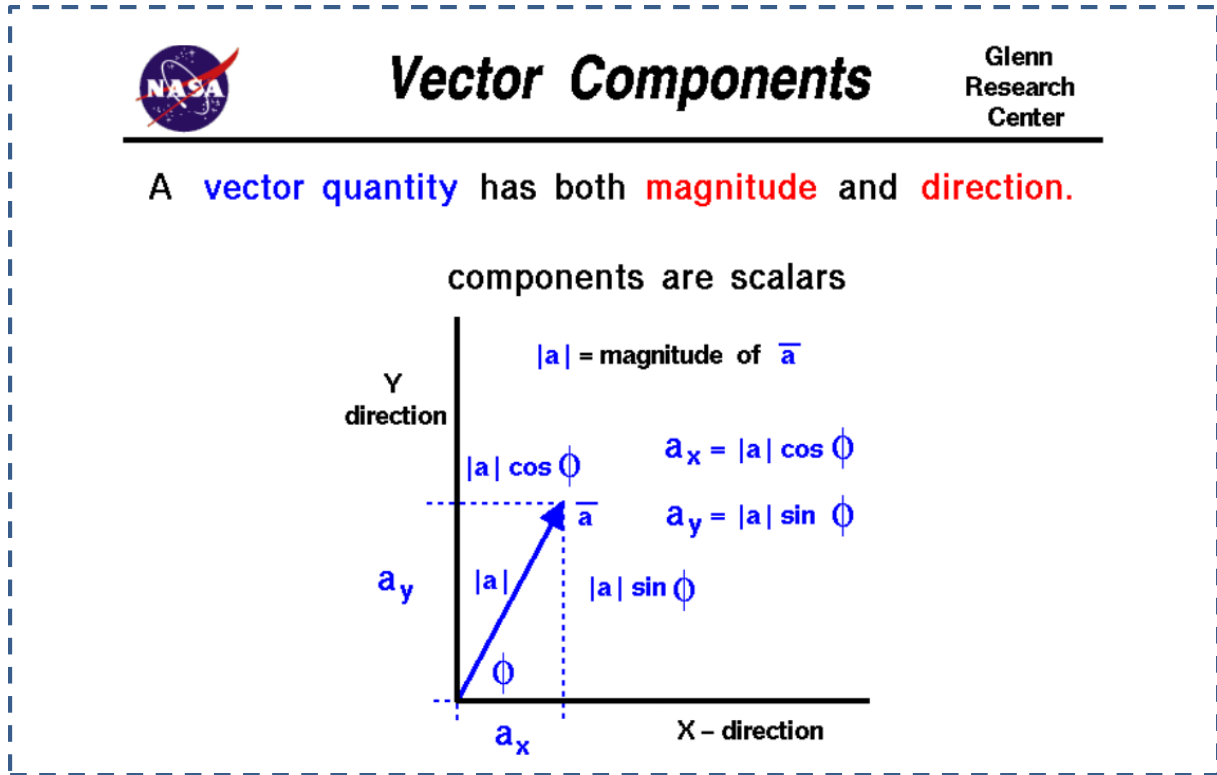


# THOUGHT FOR TODAY (OCTOBER 22, 2021)

## \*\*\*VECTOR: UNDERSTANDING THE DYNAMICS OF OUR WALK WITH GOD\*\*\*

"For we **walk by faith**, not by sight." (2 Corinthians 5:7, NKJV)

"Those who are **led by the Spirit of God** are children of God." (Romans 8:14, NIRV)

A vector is represented in terms of **magnitude** and **direction**. These 2 components of a **vector** could be related to our **walk with God**:

- **Magnitude**: This is equivalent to **faith** in our walk with God. Hence, our **faith** could be great or little or weak or strong (Matthew 8:10, Matthew 8:26, Romans 4:19-21, 1Corinthians 16:13).
- **Direction**: This is equivalent to following **the leading of the Holy Spirit** in our walk with God.

Despite the obvious leading of the Holy Spirit, the **faith** of Elijah was **strong** when he outran the chariot of King Ahab (1Kings 18:46) and **weak** when Peter began to sink upon invitation by Jesus to join him to walk on water (Matthew 14:30). Similarly, the **leading of the Holy Spirit** and **faith** were evident in the life of Jesus (John 2:1-12), Peter/Cornelius (Acts 10:1-48), Paul (Acts 16:1-40), etc.

As children of God, we move (walk) in the **direction** the **Holy Spirit is leading** and **faith** is a **determinant** of the **magnitude (distance)** we go. Selah.
