GENERAL INFORMATION

Rongai Secondary School (Rongai Boys) is a double-stream boarding school located within Rongai Township 35 km from Nakuru, with a maximum capacity of 400 boys. It is a private school owned by the Catholic Diocese of Nakuru and administered by the De La Salle Christian Brothers.

The adequate facilities at the school include: Classrooms, a multi-purpose hall, Dining hall, a library, science laboratories, dormitories and a modern computer laboratory.

The school has regular water supply from its bore hole. There is electricity from the KPLC and the school's standby generator.

The school has a holistic approach to education where we are committed to providing both human and Christian education; with emphases on Academic Excellence, Community Service, Faith and Character Formation.

The agricultural products raised from the farm include: **Chicken, eggs, meat, milk and vegetables.**

SCHOOL PROGRAMME: We follow the regular 8-4-4 academic program. The 9 acre school compound consists of the buildings and a "**Model Farm**". Apart from academic schedule, the students are directly responsible of our crops and animals (**chickens, cattle, pigs, sheep**) husbandry; they also serve each other by undertaking all cleaning work plus other manual work. **Form 1 and 2 students work while the Form 3 students are trained as "Managers"**). Our form 1 and 2 students are also assigned a one week duty either during the midterm or holiday breaks to work either in the small-scale farm or livestock section.

Rongai Boys being a school founded on Catholic Church traditions, all students are encouraged and required to fully participate in the school spiritual formation programmes. All lessons begin and end with prayers. All students must attend the Wednesday and Sunday Mass. Students are also encouraged to join prayer groups/ clubs and any other club that interests them. Morning mass is optional. There is Catechism, Guidance and counseling.
