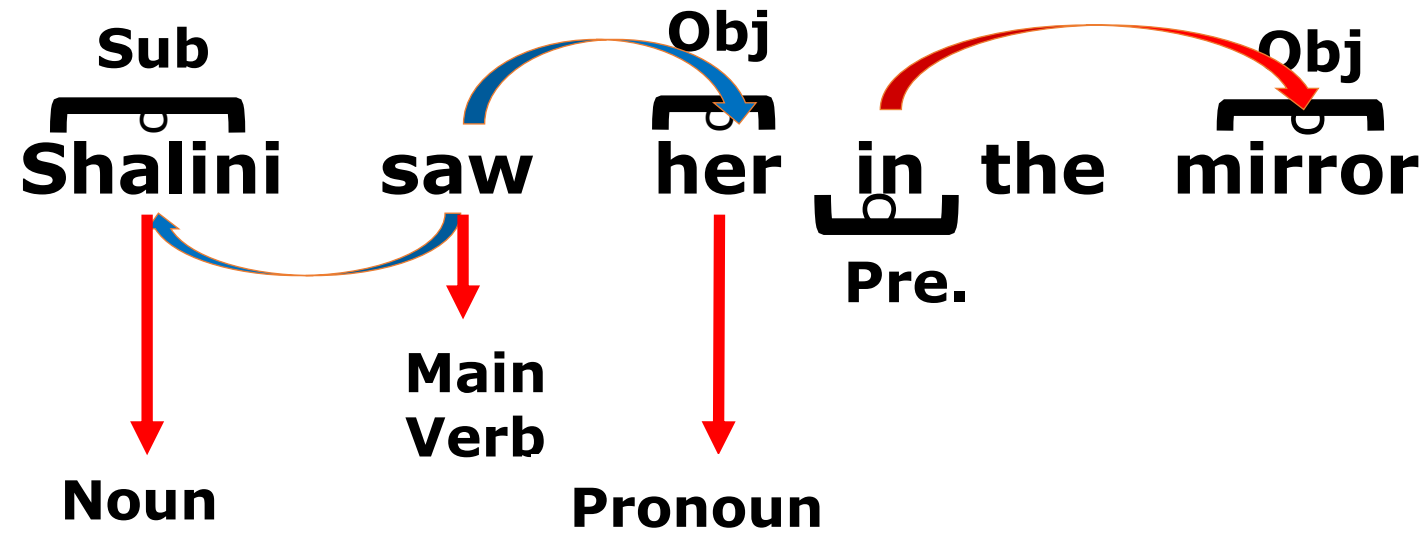

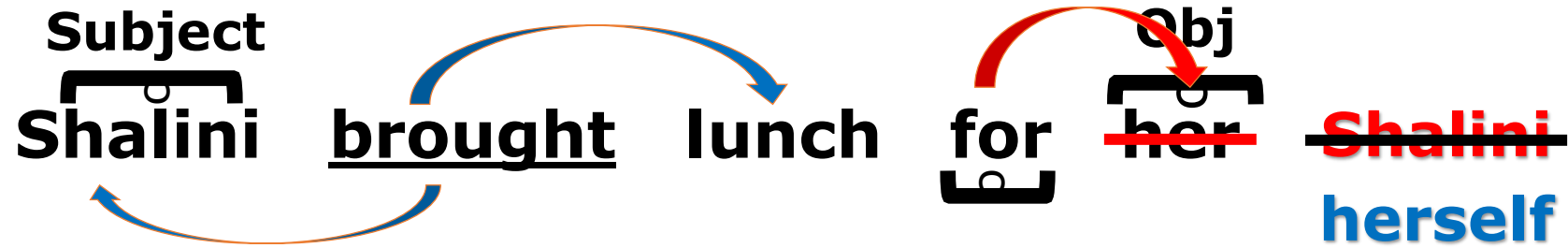

Shalini **herself** praised the movie

Shalini ने **खुद** movie को praise किया

Alternative form

→ Shalini praised the movie **herself**

Subject (Doer) → Shalini

Object (Receiver) → Shalini

Subject = Object → Use **Reflexive Pronoun**

Subject = Object of Preposition → Use **Reflexive Pronoun**

Reflexive Pronoun = After verb || **Emphatic Pronoun** = Before verb

Confusion – 1 (Practice)

- All the girls **themselves** prepared the cake
- ❑ The mechanic repaired himself the bike
- The mechanic **himself** repaired the bike
- ❑ I paid myself the EMI of the loan
- I **myself** paid the EMI of the loan
- ❑ Myself reached New York to apply for the job
- **I** reached New York to apply for the job
- ❑ We ourselves motivated ourselves to be successful
- We **ourselves** motivated **ourselves** to be successful

Reflexive Verbs

- **Category I:** Introduce, Satisfy, **Enjoy**, Avail, Pride, prostrate, promote, Absent, Present, hurt
 - **Category II:** Reconcile, Resign, Submit, Apply, Help, Behave, adjust, acquit, adapt

- She **enjoyed** in the picnic
 - She **enjoyed herself** a lot in the picnic
 - She **enjoyed** my company a lot in the picnic

Reflexive Verbs

- **Category I:** Introduce, Satisfy, Enjoy, **Avail**, Pride, prostrate, promote, Absent, Present, hurt
- **Category II:** Reconcile, Resign, Submit, Apply, Help, Behave, adjust, acquit, adapt

- ❑ The poor **availed of** the pension scheme
- ❑ The poor **availed** himself/herself of the pension scheme
- ❑ The poor **availed themselves of** the pension scheme
- ❑ They tried to do everything to reach in time but to no **avail**

The + Adjectives = Common plural Nouns

(The **Rich**, The **poor**, The **French**, The **Weak**)

←To no **avail**/ of no **avail** → **No reflexive pronoun**

Reflexive Verbs

- **Category I:** Introduce, **Satisfy**, Enjoy, Avail, Pride, prostrate, promote, Absent, Present, hurt
- **Category II:** Reconcile, Resign, Submit, Apply, Help, Behave, adjust, acquit, adapt

- She **satisfied** that all doors were locked
- She **satisfied** herself that all door were locked
- She was not **satisfied** with the answer
- She was not **satisfied** ~~herself~~ with the answer

Satisfied (**Verb**) → to satisfy someone

Satisfy (**Adj**) → संतुष्ट

Reflexive Verbs

 - The magician **introduced** himself/ herself to the audience
 - The magician **introduced** his/her assistant to the audience

Reflexive Verbs

- The man **presented** in the court
- The man **presented himself** in the court
- The man **presented** a cheque to the banker
- They **absented** from the meeting
- They **absented themselves** from the meeting
- She was **absent** ~~herself~~ in the meeting

Absent (**Verb**) → To be absent

Absent (**Adj**) → गायब

Reflexive Verbs

He **reconciled himself to** his fate **To accept a situation**

He **reconciled** with his father **Reunite**

Reflexive Verbs

- **Category II:** Reconcile, Resign, Submit, Apply, Help, Behave, adjust, acquit, adapt

She **resigned** from her job | She **resigned** herself **to** the destiny

Yash **applied** for a job | Yash **applied** himself **to** the job

The judge **acquitted** the accused | The player **acquitted** himself well

He **behaves** rudely | She is not **behaving** herself today

They **submitted** a request | They **submitted** themselves **to** the pressure

You should **help** me | you should **help** yourself **to** the dinner

They **adjusted** their schedule | They **adjusted** themselves **to** their schedule

He **adapted** the novel for a movie | he **adapted** himself **to** the surroundings

Never-Reflexive verbs

Dress, Hide, keep, remain, bathe, shave, wash, stop, turn, move, concentrate, hurry, wake up, lie down, meet, relax

- She dressed her children for school
- She dressed ~~herself~~ for the office
- She dressed for the office

- They moved the car
- They moved ~~themselves~~ and got into the car
- They moved and got into the car
- We hurried ~~ourselves~~ to the car
