Battery-powered small to medium-sized cordless handpieces The newest entrants in the cordless field are the battery-powered handpieces. Most corded models last between three and five hours while cordless ones are usually good for eight to ten hours.

Cordless Dust Screens The latest generation of cordless handheld vacuums feature a built-in dust screen. Some models include a special tool to remove the dust safely from the air. However, it is possible for them to miss dust completely, so you should always remember to clean it before using it again.

Cartridge-driven vacuum cleaners With the invention of the new cartridge-driven hand vacuum, cleaning has been made easier. The built-in compartments of these types of devices allow the user to pick the appropriate tools needed for the job at hand. They can pick from a long hose and brush to powerful motors that will quickly clean your whole room. One thing you need to make sure you do is to make sure your cleaner has enough power.
