Check if you have installed any recent updates in your operating system and if it's an optional one, you can uninstall it and try launching the game again. The system is not up-to-date Each game or program has some specific system requirements, check if your PC is compatible or not. Insufficient connectivity is the most common reason why games do not launch. Your internet connection may not be game-optimized, and Minecraft will not start. Try switching your internet connection and start the game again. 2] Remove the launcher files that are corrupt.

The launcher's files could be damaged and the game will not launch. The only fix to this issue is to delete the launcher files from the "Minecraft" folder on your PC, but then you have to install all your profiles manually. To find the Minecraft launcher files-- Open the Run dialog box by pressing Win+R- Type %appdata%- Go to the ".minecraft" folder- Locate the file called "launcher_profiles.json" and delete it.- Launch Minecraft and make new profiles from Settings. 3. Update your graphics card driver

If you have an outdated version of the driver for graphics cards installed on your system, Minecraft will not launch. To update or repair faulty graphics drivers you can download any driver upgrader for free. This will aid in making Minecraft run smoothly. If needed, update the driver and launch the game once more. You can also search for optional driver updates.44. Run Minecraft administrator

Privilege issues may be the reason for why your game isn't launching. This issue can be fixed by running Minecraft as an administrator. Go to Minecraft, right-click, and run it as an administrator. This should solve your problem.5Remove the Minecraft Mods

Games are usually constantly adding all available mods (modifications). Modifications made by players can be used to enhance the gameplay, but they can sometimes cause problems when you launch your game. Remove all the added Minecraft Mods before launching the game.6] Re-install Minecraft

If none of these solutions works for you, then uninstall the game and reinstall. To remove MicrosoftWindows, press Win+R and enter "%appdata%"..- Go to . Right-click on the Minecraft folder.
