The Classic Panel grip was made easier than Legacy grips and was first put on J Frames in 1950. However, as handwork became more expensive, Classic Panels were replaced by Service grips. The reason was obvious: they were easier to conceal in the gun. And they were also cheaper to make than Legacy grips. Eventually, the Classic Panel was mostly replaced by the Service grip, which had a thicker, wider grip.

The Hogue S&W J Frame Round Butt Grip is a great upgrade for any gun. This textured rubber grip provides a comfortable hold and improves handling while in the field. This grip

also has a Sorbothane insert, which helps prevent the grip from slipping during a shot. The Hogue S&W J Frame Bantam handgun grip also improves shot performance and is comfortable to use.
