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1 **FIRST OBSERVATIONS:**

2  
3 On February 18<sup>th</sup>, 2023, at approximately 0214 hours, I was on patrol for the CHP West Los  
4 Angeles Area office working as unit C79-064. I was dressed in full CHP tan regulation uniform,  
5 driving a clearly marked CHP Patrol Vehicle (#1448304) and partnered with Officer  
6 Hayrabedian, I.D. 22987, who was seated in the front passenger seat. We were traveling on I-10  
7 eastbound to Fairfax Avenue in the #1 lane. My attention was drawn to a black Mercedes-Benz  
8 G63 which was traveling directly ahead of us in the #1 lane of the off-ramp. I observed the  
9 Mercedes-Benz drift to the right causing the right-side tires to cross the broken white lines  
10 delineating the #1 lane and #2 lane by approximately three feet. The Mercedes-Benz straddled  
11 both lanes for approximately 20 feet and the driver applied the brakes for no apparent reason.  
12 The Mercedes-Benz drifted back into the #1 lane. The Mercedes-Benz reached the end of the off-  
13 ramp in the left turn lane, then abruptly veered into the #1 lane, activated its right turn signal, and  
14 continued veering to the right into the #2 lane. I positioned the patrol vehicle behind the  
15 Mercedes-Benz as it came to a stop behind a vehicle that was stopped at a phased red traffic  
16 signal at Fairfax Avenue. I observed the Mercedes-Benz did not have a month or year  
17 registration tab affixed to the rear license plate, a violation of 5204(a) VC (*Current month and*  
18 *year tabs shall be attached to rear license plate*). The driver of the Mercedes-Benz made a right  
19 turn onto southbound Fairfax Avenue, and I followed it. I activated the patrol vehicle's  
20 emergency lights, initiating an enforcement stop. The driver of the Mercedes-Benz moved along  
21 the right curb and came to a stop.

22  
23 **OBSERVATIONS AFTER THE STOP:**

24  
25 I exited the patrol vehicle and made a driver side approach and Officer Hayrabedian made a  
26 passenger side approach. The left rear window had heavy window tint to the point where I could  
27 not see inside the vehicle. I instructed the driver to put down all the windows and he did not  
28 comply. Again, I instructed the driver to put down all the windows. The driver was slow to react,  
29 but finally put the left rear window down. I advised the driver the reason for the stop and  
30 requested his identification through the open driver side window. The driver handed me his valid  
31 Texas Driver License, positively identifying him as **Anthony William Farrer**. I could smell the  
32 strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from the vehicle. While speaking with Farrer I  
33 noticed his eyes were red and watery and his speech appeared slurred. I asked Farrer how much  
34 alcohol he had consumed, and he stated he had 4 drinks. I asked Farrer to exit the vehicle and  
35 meet me by the patrol vehicle. I asked Farrer a series of Pre-field sobriety test (pre-FST)  
36 questions. While asking Farrer the pre-FST questions, I smelled the odor of an alcoholic  
37 beverage emitting from his breath and about his person. I asked Farrer to perform a series of  
38 Field Sobriety tests. Farrer stated he had lived in California for one year. A DMV inquiry by  
39 name and date of birth showed no match to a California Driver License.

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1 **FIELD SOBRIETY TESTS:**

2  
3 These FST's were explained and demonstrated, and I received affirmation Farrer understood the  
4 instructions prior to performing each test.

5  
6 **HORIZONTAL GAZE NYSTAGMUS:**

7  
8 I noticed the eyes of Farrer displayed lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes. Distinct and Sustained  
9 nystagmus at maximum deviation was present in both eyes of Farrer. Nystagmus was also visible  
10 at an angle of onset prior to 45 degrees in both eyes. Farrer swayed approximately 1-2 inches  
11 from centerline throughout this FST.

12  
13 **WALK AND TURN:**

14  
15 Farrer declined to perform this FST stating he had, "Pins in his feet."

16  
17 **ONE LEG STAND:**

18  
19 Farrer declined to perform this FST stating he had, "Pins in his feet."

20  
21 **PRELIMINARY ALCOHOL SCREENING (PAS) DEVICE:**

23 Farrer declined to perform this FST.

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1 **ARREST:**

2  
3 Based on Farrer's poor driving, signs and symptoms of alcoholic intoxication, his answers to the  
4 pre-FST questions, and his poor performance on FST's, I formed the opinion Farrer had been  
5 driving a motor vehicle while under the influence of an alcoholic beverage and his continued  
6 operation of a motor vehicle would be unsafe.

7  
8 Farrer was standing to the right rear of my patrol vehicle on the sidewalk. At approximately 0224  
9 hours, I instructed Farrer to turn around and place his hands behind his back. Farrer abruptly  
10 turned around and ran away from me in a northerly direction along the west sidewalk of Fairfax  
11 Avenue. Officer Hayrabedian and I chased Farrer on foot and Hayrabedian notified CHP  
12 dispatch of the foot pursuit. Farrer ran onto Fairfax Avenue, then turned around and began  
13 running in a southerly direction through southbound and northbound lanes. Farrer ran towards  
14 Washington Boulevard in front of a vehicle which had stopped to avoid colliding into Farrer, my  
15 partner, and I. Farrer began running eastbound in westbound lanes on Washington Boulevard,  
16 east of Fairfax Avenue. Farrer abruptly came to a stop in the middle of westbound lanes. I  
17 tackled Farrer to the ground, after pursuing him on foot for approximately 330 feet. Farrer placed  
18 his hands behind his back. Officer Hayrabedian held Farrer's right arm in place, and I placed  
19 handcuffs on Farrer, placing him under arrest at 0225 hours for violation of 23152(a) V.C.  
20 (*Driving under the influence of an alcoholic beverage*) and 148(a)(1) P.C. (*Willfully resisting,*  
21 *delaying, or obstructing a Peace Officer*). At some point during the foot pursuit, the passenger in  
22 the left rear seat exited the Mercedes-Benz and walked towards the patrol vehicle.

23  
24 My partner and I walked Farrer to the patrol vehicle, and I conducted a full standing search of  
25 him. I advised Farrer of 23612 V.C. (Implied Consent) and he refused to choose a test. Farrer  
26 stated he would not cooperate without speaking to his lawyer. Unit 79-S7 (Sergeant Drum, I.D.  
27 20740) arrived on scene. Sergeant Drum began a vehicle inventory and located a pepper gun  
28 wedged between the driver seat and center console, which is legal to have in his possession. The  
29 pepper gun was left in the trunk of the Mercedes-Benz. I placed Farrer in the right rear seat of the  
30 patrol vehicle. I asked Farrer if he had any injuries and he stated he did not.

31  
32 At approximately 0245 hours, I read page 2 of the DMV DS 367 verbatim to Farrer. I asked  
33 Farrer if he would take a breath test and he stated, "No." I asked Farrer if he would take a blood  
34 test and he stated, "I will not." I asked Farrer if what I read to him made sense to him and he  
35 stated it did. I asked Farrer if he had any questions and he stated he did not.

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1 **ARREST (Continued):**

2  
3 Officer Hayrabedian and I transported Farrer to Gardena Memorial Hospital, and I applied for a  
4 search warrant for a sample of Farrer's blood due to his chemical test refusal. Sergeant Drum  
5 followed us to the hospital. At approximately 0309 hours, I received a signed search warrant for  
6 a sample of Farrer's blood from the honorable Judge Steven Blades out of Clara Shortridge Foltz  
7 Superior Court, Department M.U.

8  
9 At approximately 0318 hours, I observed CPT1 Cielo Fabonan clean the right arm of Farrer with  
10 povidone iodine then draw one vial of blood, which was later booked at LAPD 77<sup>th</sup> Division,  
11 DR#239907969. I recorded the blood draw, and the CD was booked at the CHP West Los  
12 Angeles Area Office Evidence Room, Evidence #E20230054. After Farrer's blood draw he  
13 received medical clearance from the medical staff at the hospital. Farrer stated he did not have  
14 any injuries. Officer Hayrabedian and I transported Farrer to LAPD 77<sup>th</sup> Division where he was  
15 booked without further incident.

16  
17 **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

19 I recommend the following charges are filed against **Anthony William Farrer:**
