'Minecraft Earth' Early Access Comes to the uK and 8 other Countries

Minecraft Earth's early access version is now rolling out to countries around the world but it's not accessible where you'd expect it. Minecraft news Mojang and Microsoft have confirmed that the game's augmented reality is now available on Android and iOS in nine countries. The UK is the most recent update however, it's been available for some time in Australia, Canada, Iceland, Mexico, New Zealand and the Philippines, South Korea and Sweden.

You've likely noticed that the US and many other countries aren't included on the list. The developers are planning to bring Earth to more countries in the next few weeks. The creators want to be sure the game is ready for a major launch. The early access version isn't a full representation of what the game will ultimately include. It's possible that you're missing out, but your patience might be rewarded with more content in the long run.
