
## **Gastritis: Symptoms and Causes**

2. **Causes** - Gastritis occurs when there is inflammation present in the lining of the stomach. This inflammation is caused by infections by certain bacteria that enter the system through unsanitary food or beverages. Besides this, regular use of pain relievers can trigger gastritis as well.
