CIRCUMFERENCE TEST

Use a flexible measuring tape (or a string & ruler) to measure your finger circumference.

Wrap it snugly around your finger for an accurate measurement.

If using a string or ribbon, cut right where the 2 ends meet.

Be careful not to wrap the string too tight.

Aim for a comfortable, snug fit.

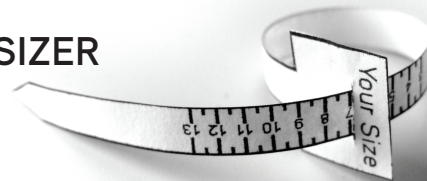
Double check for accuracy.

With a ruler, measure the length of the string in cm or inch.

The result is your finger circumference.

Look up your size by referring to the chart on the left.

PRINTABLE RING SIZER



MAKE SURE DOCUMENT IS PRINTED AT 100%

If you printed at 100%, the rectangle on the right should measure 1" wide.

1 INCH

Carefully cut out the paper ring sizer below.

Using a cutter, create a slit by making a small cut on the dashed line labeled "Your Size".

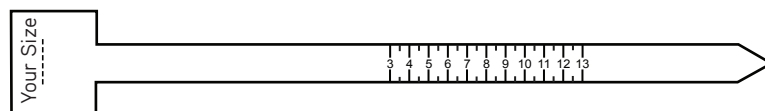
Insert the pointy end through the slit creating a circle.

Place around your finger and pull the pointed end to create a snug fit.

The number line located at the "Your Size" slit, is the proper ring size.

Be careful not to wrap the paper too tight.

Aim for a comfortable, snug fit.



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
