THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

COUNTS ONE - FOUR
(18 U.S.C. § 1951 - EXTORTION)

On or about the dates listed below, in the Eastern District of Michigan, Defendant CHARLES WILLS, a sworn police officer for the City of Detroit, assigned to the 8th Precinct, did knowingly and willfully obstruct, delay, and affect interstate commerce and the movement of articles and commodities in interstate commerce by extortion, by unlawfully obtaining, under color of official right, money and property from the owner/operator of an automotive collision shop, located in the City of Detroit, with his consent, which money and property was not due WILLS as a Detroit police officer or

WILLS's official position. Each of the following payments constitute a separate count of extortion:
