
As the 2024 terms are different lengths, fees will be adjusted to reflect the number of weeks in each term. You will see an increase in Term 1 and then a gradual decrease as the year continues. Please check out our pricing list on the next page for specific prices of each class and term.

2024 TERM FEES & FEE POLICY

- Fees are payable strictly in advance prior to the term commencing to secure a place in a class.
- Makeup classes can be taken where classes fall on a public holiday choose a class of your choice.
- No refunds are given for missed classes due to school camps, family holidays, birthdays etc.
- Refunds will only be given for serious illness or injury (with medical certificate) and bereavement.
- Parents must contact the office to confirm an unenrolment prior to Week 3 of term.
- There will be no refund of term fees if a student leaves a class after the first 3 weeks of term.
- Changing classes at any time will not incur any charges unless there is a discrepancy in the fees.
- Late fees will apply if term fees are received after the first week of each term.
- As our Term lengths differ, you will find a slight difference in Term prices from Term 1 2 and then Term 3 4. The prices below are for our average 9 week term Terms 2 and 3.

Dance exams are a great mid-year goal for our students. Syllabus classes prepare for the first half of the year towards these exams and students feel a great sense of achievement and pride once completed. Students then progress through their genre levels from year to year.

WHEN? Exams take place mid year and can fall anywhere between the end of Term 2 - mid Term 3

COST: Exam entry fees depend on the genre and exam level. Costs range from around \$50 - \$250.

REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible to sit an exam at Neverland Studios you must be doing the following:

- \rightleftharpoons Attending the compulsory classes suitable for your exam (can be from 1 to 3 classes per week)
 - Wearing the appropriate uniform for your exam
- 🖕 Attending any extra holiday/intensive courses that are scheduled for your exam
- Practicing at home

WHO CAN DO AN EXAM? All dancers that are following the above guidelines are eligible to sit an exam however the decision to enter a student in an exam is that of the teachers. Exam students must be showing great technique and performance quality, they must also be regularly attending class and practising in their own time. All exam students must show a positive attitude towards the syllabus, their teacher and their peers.

JAZZ - Global Dance Qualification Syllabus (GDQ)

GDQ pulls from the most well respected dance technique methods from around the world and aligns with world industry standards of what is expected from students of all ages.

BALLET - ROYAL ACADEMY OF DANCE (RAD)

RAD exams set standards in classical ballet and are a global leader in continuing professional development for dance. Founded in 1920, today RAD have a presence in 84 countries, with around 14,000 members worldwide. RAD count more than 1,000 students in their teacher training programmes and more than a quarter of a million students are being examined in RAD syllabi.

NEVERLAND STUDIOS TERMS AND CONDITIONS 2024

FEES POLICY

- Fees are payable strictly in advance prior to the term commencing to secure a place in a class.
- If you have not paid your fees and not attended class by week 3 of the term your enrolment will be cancelled.
- Make up classes will be offered when classes fall on a public holidays.
- No refunds are given for missed classes due to overseas trips, family holidays, birthdays, light flu etc. Refunds may be granted due to illness, injury or bereavement only. Medical certificates may be requested.
- There will be no refund of term fees if a student leaves a class after the first 3 weeks of attendance. If you decide to pull out of a class before your third lesson you will only be charged for the weeks that you were enrolled.
- Your enrolment will not be processed if you have an outstanding balance on your account from a previous term/year.
- Late fees will apply if terms fees are not received in the first week of Term.

PHOTOS AND DIGITAL DISPLAYS

- Neverland employees take photos/videos throughout the year. These photos/videos may be added to the Neverland Facebook or Instagram page, please make the office aware if you or your child wishes to not be in any photos/videos.
- No photos or videos are to be taken by an observer while watching a class unless the teacher has specifically
 invited you to film or photograph a dance. These videos are to not be shared on any Social Media. This is for child
 safety reasons.

EXAM POLICY

- No student is guaranteed a place in an exam.
- A nomination for an exam is based on the assumption that the student will fully commit to exam preparation.
- Students can be pulled out of an exam at any time at their teachers discretion.
- Certain syllabus classes require a minimum of 2x classes a week to be be attended (contact the office to learn more about what classes require two lessons). If classes are missed, this could jeopardise your place in an exam.
- Every student should have their correct exam uniform appropriate to their level from the beginning of the year.
- No refunds or credits of the exam fee will be given if a student pulls out of the exam UNLESS due to injury or sickness. A medical certificate may be requested and only a 50% refund will be provided.

SHOW POLICY

- Taking part in the end of year show is not compulsory although is highly recommended as it is the highlight of the year.
- A show costume fee will be included in your term 3 fees. This fee is a contribution towards sewing, purchasing, laundering, storage and handling of costumes. You do not get to keep your show costume.
- A show participation fee per family will be included in your term 3 fees included in this fee is a free show digital download.
- Attendance at show rehearsals is compulsory.
- During the show period, studio rehearsals and theatre week, there are no normal timetabled classes; please refer to your cast list (usually handed out in Term 3).

UNIFORM POLICY

- Uniform is compulsory for all classes and must be purchased and worn by the students third class.
- Continually attending class not in uniform could jeopardise your place in your class.
- Correct uniform must be worn for each genre i.e. students are not allowed to wear jazz uniform in a hip hop class.

PAYMENT T&Cs

Enrolments prior to Term 1 commencing:

- One two class enrolments per family requires full term fee payment to secure your place in the class.
- 3 or more class enrolments require a minimum deposit of \$80 PER CLASS in order to secure your place in the classes.
- If you are enrolling for Unlimited you must pay a \$550 deposit to secure all of your classes.

*If a deposit has been made, the remaining fees are due prior to Term 1 commencing.

Enrolments for Term 1 - Term 4:

Once the dancing term has started - full term fee payment is required for ALL enrolments and must be made on date of enrolment.

Once you have enrolled, your enrollment will automatically roll over to the following terms. Full class payment is required prior to the term commencing. Students with outstanding fees from a prior term or year will not be enrolled in any class until full payment is made.
