Dear Sidhas and Meditators,

Teachers of the Transcendental Meditation (TM®) technique are greatly needed to meet the growing demand for the TM program in professional environments, such as corporate, government, and military settings. Younger teachers are also needed for programs in schools.

In response to these needs, we are pleased to announce that the next International Transcendental Meditation Teacher Training Course (TTC) is tentatively planned for April–September 2022, lasting just over 22 weeks.

The dates of the course will be announced when the COVID situation allows us to hold the course. For now, the need is to complete the TTC Application and Learning Program.

A team of experienced TM teachers and administrators provide support and assistance to applicants throughout the application process and during the course itself; and continuing support and apprenticeship are provided following graduation from TTC as you begin your teaching career.

Teacher Training Course details

What is needed to apply

- **Two-Year Commitment after becoming a Transcendental Meditation Teacher:** Priority will be given to applicants who commit to work full time, teaching the Transcendental Meditation technique for at least two years after completion of TTC. The twoyear commitment will apply especially for those seeking scholarships.
- **Practicing the Transcendental Meditation Sidhi ProgramSM** for at least three months before the start of TTC: Meditators who are not yet Sidhas should immediately apply for the TM-Sidhi[®] course to complete instruction at least three months before the start of TTC.

Note: The cost of the TM-Sidhi course and any requirements for Advanced Techniques are not included in the TTC fee.

Structure, Dates, Location, Schedule, and Costs

Dates of the upcoming TM-Sidhi courses (also known as “Center Invincibility Course” or “CIC”):

CIC Part 1: December 2–19, 2021. Twelve two-hour sessions— to be held on Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, over three consecutive weeks

CIC Part 2: December 26, 2021–January 9, 2022. Two-week, in-residence portion of CIC (for all who successfully complete Part 1 of the TM-Sidhi course)

Note: Final dates will be announced, subject to COVID guidelines. Verification of COVID vaccination is required for participation in both blocks. Face masks may be required, and social distancing will be practiced.

Location of the upcoming CIC/TM-Sidhi course

At this time, CIC is only available in Fairfield, IA, on the campus of Maharishi International University (MIU).

Schedule of the upcoming CIC

Part 1: The “in-Center” portion of training: December 2–19, 2021, is held on three consecutive weekends, approximately two hours each day/evening.

Housing and food costs for Part 1 are the responsibility of each course participant.

▶ Applicants should apply for CIC in conjunction with the TTC application. CIC applicants should therefore contact Bobbi Ringwalt as soon as possible at cicfairfield@tm.org or (319) 400-5010 to begin the CIC application process and for more information on CIC requirements, including Advanced Techniques.

Note: Meditators must have attended one weekend TM Retreat within 12 months prior to applying for the TM-Sidhi course.

Part 2: Two-week in-residence portion of training: December 26, 2021–January 9, 2022

Cost of CIC/TM-Sidhi course:

(Note: Fees must be paid in full before the start of the course.)

- **Adults:** \$2,000
- **Full-time students:** \$2,000
- **Full-time MIU-Fairfield students:** \$1,000

Cost of Two-Week In-Residence Block at Maharishi International University, Fairfield, Iowa (includes housing and meals):

- **Dormitory on MIU campus:** \$950
- **Room in Maharishi Peace Palace:** \$1,570 (subject to availability)
- **Age of applicants:** Younger adults—including recent college graduates and young professionals from around the world—are especially encouraged to apply. However, all interested candidates are warmly welcome to apply.
- **Applicants should have a strong ability to memorize** a large amount of information.
- **Pre-TTC study assignments:** For TTC 2022, applicants are required to complete several weeks of pre-TTC study assignments at home before receiving acceptance to the course. For this reason, it is important to apply early in order to learn the necessary material for the study assignments and meet the TTC acceptance standards.
- **Language:** The course lessons will be in English.
- **Health insurance:** Course participants are required to have health insurance that covers them at the course location. (More information about this requirement is supplied later in the full application process.)



Course location and accommodations

Men's and women's courses will be held concurrently in Chanthaburi, Thailand, at separate locations, with no interaction between the courses. This will allow maximum focus on the rich curriculum Maharishi structured for the Transcendental Meditation Teacher Training Course.



Rajapark Institute Training Center, in Chanthaburi, Thailand, is set amidst 124 acres of beautiful orchards and local shrubbery, with easy walking trails.

This unique campus was designed and built according to Maharishi Vastu® architecture (in harmony with natural law). There are four main buildings, set around a central pavilion. (See campus photos above and below.) The peaceful atmosphere of the campus is enriched with the blissful influence of advanced TM courses held there over many years.

Recently renovated, single-occupancy en-suite bedrooms; comfortable, spacious classrooms and meditation halls; and nourishing vegetarian meals support a smooth experience of the focused daily TTC routine.



Course fee

The course fee is \$19,500, which includes tuition and full room and board for the length of the course. Candidates who are accepted to the course and demonstrate financial need may apply for a partial scholarship.

Expenses

Expenses for all transportation, visas, health and COVID insurance, and other incidentals are the responsibility of each course participant.

Application opening and closing dates and fees

TTC application is online. Applications for TTC 2022 are open and must be completed by October 31, 2021.

Pre-TTC study assignments at home: The TTC Home Learning Program commences November 1, 2021, and a passing grade must be achieved before acceptance to the Thailand In-Residence section of the course.

Non-refundable application fee and late-fee schedule: (The non-refundable application fee is deducted from the TTC course fee, if the applicant attends TTC.)

- October 1 – 31, 2021: US\$300 non-refundable deposit

All application details must be completed by the application closing date. Once you have completed the Register Interest form, you will be notified how to proceed. For more information, please visit TeacherTraining.TM.Org.
