What's on at Hokitika's Regent Theatre.

BAD BEHAVIOUR(M) This film is a dark comedy about Lucy, a former child actress who seeks some answers to life at a retreat lead by a spiritual leader. Of course she is also navigating the close yet turbulent relationship with her daughter, who is also an actress, but she is a stunt performer.

DUMB MONEY (M) Dumb Money tells the story of fortunes made and lost overnight in the David-vs.-Goliath GameStop short squeeze that may have changed Wall Street forever. It offers a scathing, funny and emotional portrayal of how a loosely affiliated group of amateur investors and internet denizens crushed one of the biggest hedge funds on Wall Street and upended the establishment.

EXHIBITION ON SCREEN: MARY CASSAT

Mary Cassatt made a career painting the lives of the women around her. Her radical images showed them as intellectual, feminine and real, which was a major shift in the way women appeared in art.

Presenting her astonishing prints, pastels, and paintings, this film introduces us to the often-overlooked Impressionist whose own career was as full of contradiction as the women she painted.

FIVE NIGHTS AT FREDDY'S (M) Can you survive five nights? The terrifying horror game phenomenon becomes a blood-chilling cinematic event, The film follows a troubled security guard as he begins working at Freddy Fazbear's Pizza. While spending his first night on the job, he realizes the night shift at Freddy's won't be so easy to make it through. The film's iconic animatronic characters are created by Jim Henson's Creature Shop.

HEADSPACE (PG) After chasing the evil and yet very small Zolthard through a wormhole, 3 aliens find themselves stranded in the brain of 16yr old Norman. Norman is an average teenage boy, with an above average concern for the planet. Zolthard will stop at nothing to get his fleet of droids to invade Earth and dominate the giant humans that roam it.

KILLERS OF FLOWER MOON (M) At the turn of the 20th century, oil brought a fortune to the Osage Nation, who became some of the richest people in the world overnight. The wealth of these Native Americans immediately attracted white interlopers, who manipulated, extorted, and stole as much Osage money as they could before resorting to murder. Based on a true story and told through the improbable romance of Ernest Burkhart (Leonardo DiCaprio) and Mollie Kyle (Lily Gladstone), this is an epic western crime saga, where real love crosses paths with unspeakable betrayal.

LOOP TRACK (R16) Loop Track follows a highly anxious man (Tom Sainsbury) on the verge of a breakdown, as he sets off on a 4 day hike through NZ bush to clear his head. What starts as a simple walk in the wilderness turns into a fight for survival.

SAW X (R18) John Kramer (Tobin Bell) is back. The most chilling instalment of the SAW franchise yet explores the untold

chapter of Jigsaw's most personal game. Set between the events of SAW I and II, a sick and desperate John travels to Mexico for a risky and experimental medical procedure in hopes of a miracle cure for his cancer - only to discover the entire operation is a scam to defraud the most vulnerable. Armed with a newfound purpose, John returns to his work, turning the tables on the con artists in his own way through a series of ingenious and terrifying traps .

STOP MAKING SENSE—TALKING HEADS—REMASTERED (G) The frantic energy and artsy groove of Talking Heads in this concert movie will take fans back to 1983—Hollywood Pantages Theatre and the bands front man David Byrne—a true live wire on stage.

THE HUNGER GAMES: THE BALLAD OF SONGBIRDS AND SNAKE (M) The story of Coriolanus Snow, years before he would

become the tyrannical President of Panem. He is handsome and charming, and though the Snow family has fallen on hard times, Coriolanus sees a chance for a change in his fortunes when he is chosen to be a mentor for the 10th Hunger Games only to have his elation dashed when he is assigned to mentor a girl tribute named Lucy Gray Baird from the impoverished District 12.
