

How to Get CISA Certification

If you're considering getting an CISA certification, you will have to complete an CISA Application Form. The forms need you to submit information of your experiences, CPE requirements, and signatures of verifiers. If you're interested in applying for the CISA position, you should first fill out the application form and then submit your application to ISACA. This will ensure your application is properly processed and that you've got all of the documentation needed to become a CISA.

The test to earn CISA certification is offered in a variety of languages and consists of 150 multiple-choice tests that cover five exam domains. The cost for CISA certification is a one-time fee of \$575 to join the ISACA members, while non-members have to shell out \$760. After you have completed your application and paid the fee, you're able to begin studying for the CISA test. You'll need to study extensively prior to the test so be sure to practice for the exam as often as you can.
