


I am having a publishing site and I have created a simple list as below(Screen01);

Screen01



Because of that Column, I can not use the Datasheet View for Data Entry. It is giving folowing error(Screen02)



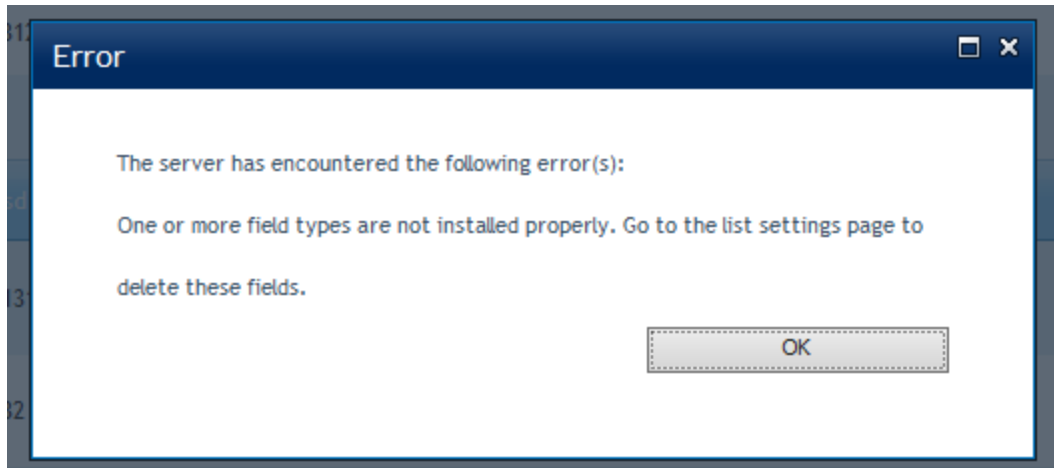
