THE POST-STANDARD MASTERS RULES

- The tournament is certified by the United States Bowling Congress and all participants must be certified by the USBC. This is a single entry tournament. Entrants must be 18 by 2/8/20. Junior bowlers are not permitted.
- Distribution of Entry Fee: Prize fund \$25.50, Tournament Expense \$19.50. In addition to position prizes, squad prizes for high series and high game may be paid. The prize fund is entry based.
- Eligibility: This tournament is open to members of the USBC who reside within the geographical boundaries of Onondaga, Cayuga, Chenango, Madison, Oswego, Tompkins, Jefferson, Oneida, Cortland Lewis, Broome, Tioga, Schuyler, Seneca, Yates, Ontario, Wayne or Monroe counties.
- This is a double-elimination scratch tournament. A bowler, once qualified in positions 1-128, must lose twice before being eliminated. A bowler in the winners' bracket will not oppose a bowler in the losers' bracket until the finals, which is a top 4 style bowl down.
- Any current exempt PBA Members or anyone who has won a PBA National Event in the past 10 years are not eligible. Last year's champion, if entered, and the top 127 qualifiers enter double elimination finals.
- Each participant is responsible for the accuracy of his score record, and must submit that record to the tournament office as directed.
- Bowlers entering the tournament and failing to report for qualifying round forfeit entry fee. If a bowler is entering a substitute, tournament management must be notified two hours prior to the announced starting time of the qualifying squad. No substitutes will be allowed after the qualifying squad has started. There will be no substitutions or alternates allowed in any match play round.
- Bowlers in the three-game qualifying round will change lanes for each game as directed by the tournament management. Tournament management reserves the right to move participants to different lanes or different squads in the event of mechanical failures or other unforeseen difficulties.
- Double elimination match play will consist of three games bowled on the same pair of lanes. Ties in any match will be broken by a 9th and 10th frame roll off.
- Premature termination of the tournament brought about by a declared emergency, natural disaster or any other reason beyond the control of tournament management shall cause, to the extent of required thereby, all advertised prizes, guaranteed or otherwise, to be pro-rated in accordance with the number of entrants and/or matches having bowled up to the time of such termination.
- Any ties for 127th place will be decided in a 3-game roll off on 2/10/20 at 5:30 p.m. at AMF Strike 'n' Spare.
- Hats or shorts will NOT be allowed in match play.
- The tournament director has final say on all disputes.
