Over the course of the past few days, we have witnessed an unprecedented attack on basic human decency and civil rights. The perpetrator of these attacks have been an administration, led by a hateful and intolerant tyrant who calls himself the 45th president of the United States. Let us declare it plainly and with conviction that we do not recognize his rule, nor do we recognize the rule of his regime.

His unconstitutional executive orders have threatened the rights of nearly every single demographic in this country. His plans to build a border wall between the United States and Mexico will come out of the American taxpayer. Refusing immigration from Muslim countries sets a precedent for an isolationist ideology that, according to history, is what perpetuated World Wars. This administration's silence on six journalists arrested and charged with felony rioting simply for doing their jobs is unacceptable. Stifling the EPA and the National Parks Services from speaking on climate change only because this so-called president was offended by their posts of his poorly-attended inauguration is unacceptable. Peddling blatant lies about the crowd of his inauguration size and then calling them "alternative facts" is unacceptable. Reopening CIA black sites and re-negotiating enhanced interrogation techniques is unacceptable. Threatening martial law on the streets of Chicago is unacceptable. Defunding sanctuary cities for immigrants is unacceptable. Expediting the Dakota Access Pipeline is unacceptable. Let this be a reminder that we were against Hillary Clinton just as we are against Donald Trump, because our aim is to bring real, radical, and influential change. We also find it noteworthy to recognize the Egyptian Revolution and to commemorate those who fought and died for freedom. The 25th of January lives on as Egyptians continue to resist every dictator that comes and tries to take advantage of them.
