- 1. Members going door to door asking for donations.
- 2. Members doing hard labour work like weeding, making bricks.

So far, financial problems are the main drawback faced by the production.

### ACHIEVEMENTS

Within the first two years of existence YSMP was able to achieve the following:

- 1. The production of a Ramadan series featuring 36 episodes.
- 2. 'The Tobaski Special'. A 35 minute movie in celebration of the Sacrificial Feast.
- 3. 'Li chi Kerr Gi'. this is a 35 minute movie, featured in a particular compound, that discourages youngsters to migrate illegally by selling family properties for travel expenses.
- 4. 'The Twist'. This trilogy shows the effect of drug in our society.
- 5. 'The Shadow of our culture'. This trilogy aims at bringing back the lost African culture by using the new media.
- 6. 'Who to blame?', our current movie project.

The production is currently embarking on an African movie project which is slated to commence 2019. Please support Young Stars Movie Production in the Gambia to support others and continue to educate, empower and entertain through acting and comedy using the new media.

However, in a country like the Gambia where lots of people struggle to feed their families, producing a movie or even act in one are looked upon as stupid dreams. A waste of time.
