

## **Call for Expression of Interest**

### ***Proposals to contribute to the Critical Media Literacy Project***

The United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) Kosovo Office is supporting capacity development through a participatory, human-centered project on critical media literacy that will contribute to the empowerment of young people to exercise agency over the interpretation of what they see, hear, and read, to be positive contributors to society, to challenge anti-social messages, and to serve as agents of social change. To achieve this, a module-based training for critical media literacy has been developed as the foundation to other related youth-led activities. This project is well-grounded in a human rights-based approach to learning. Its purpose is to foster literacy of mass media and critical approaches to information among adolescents.

UNICEF Kosovo Office is inviting civil society organizations (CSOs) to submit proposals with concrete actions aimed at achieving specific results outlined in the detailed Call for Expression of Interest which can be found in the [UNICEF Kosovo Programme Facebook page](#) together with the application forms and detailed instructions on submission.

- B) CSO Identification Profile

***The proposals must be delivered in a sealed envelope to UNICEF, Rexhep mala Street, nr. 7 Prishtina by 6 June 2016 with the remark: Call for Expression of Interest for Proposals to contribute to the Critical Media Literacy Project.***
